Conditions Governing the Receipt of Items Loaned to the UDT-SEAL Museum Association, Inc.

- 1. For the period of the loan, the items will be sub-loaned by the UDT-SEAL Museum Association, Inc., to the UDT-SEAL Museum. They may be displayed, stored, or otherwise used by the Museum, at our discretion, subject, however, to the Museum exercising the same care and decision in such display, use and storage as is customary in dealing with similar items owned by, or loaned to, the Museum Association.
- It is further agreed that each item will, while on display, be identified as the property of the lender.
- 3. After receiving reasonable notice, the Museum Association will return items loaned by the lender on presentation of this receipt.
- 4. Any item that has been left with the Museum Association as a loan for a period of five years from the date hereof, without a request having been made for its return, in consideration for its storage and safeguarding during said time, shall, after said five years, be deemed an unrestricted gift to the Museum Association and shall thereupon become the property of the Museum Association.
- 5. If for any reason the existing Museum were to permanently close, all efforts would be made to relocate and open a like Museum at a suitable location. Barring that, all items will either be returned to the donor or dispersed in accordance with the desires of the donor, or his/her appointed agent.
