HIGHPOINT AND CLASS RULES

- Daily Highpoint Divisions: Youth, Junior, Adult, and Seasoned for Walk, Trot and Walk, Trot, Canter. (Walk only
 will have separate prizes) You must show your age division and specific gait. The pattern class is calculated in,
 but Equitation is the tiebreaker.
- Stock type horses are quarter horse type horses. Non-Stock Type are other breeds, like Arabian, TB, Etc.
- Open Pattern Classes are the only classes with riding patterns. There will be no rail work in this class. Patterns will have a walk/trot and walk/trot/canter option. Participants will be required to ride the pattern according to their division. Example: If you ride in classes 18 and 19, you'll choose the walk/trot pattern to perform. If you ride in classes 27 and 28, you'll choose the canter pattern.
- Points calculated are on horse and rider combo for your division. Multiple horses require multiple back numbers.
- You must show your age division and level as of January 1st. NO CROSS ENTERING unless OPEN CLASS.
- Management reserves the right to have unruly horses, exhibitors, handlers, or spectators removed from the show grounds, with NO REFUNDS given. Classes may be combined or split at the judge's discretion. They are judged separately.
- No cross entering from walk/trot to walk/trot/canter or vice versa in age division classes. The only time you can go
 from walk/trot to walk/trot/canter is in the open classes. If you are riding a green horse and want to do an open
 walk trot class before your division, that's fine too.
- If you are showing multiple horses, you must fill out a separate registration form for each horse you are riding.
- Show All Day fee is per horse and rider combo.
- Bitless bridles are acceptable. Adult western riders must wear a hat. All riders under 18 must wear a helmet.
- Training aids are allowed in Open Schooling Classes.
- All ages pattern class: This is a pattern only class designed to test your riding skills and earn extra points for division highpoint. You will enter the arena and do your pattern and exit the arena. There will be no rail work for this class.
- Open poles and cross rail classes. There will be a minimum of 4 jumps or poles.
- Lead-line and Walk Only: Lead-line riders must be led with a lead-line attached to the horse. Walk riders may have assistance from a parent or trainer walking next to the horse if needed.
- Bareback classes: Ride at your own risk! You may ride English or Western. We may call for a canter. If you are a
 walk trot rider, you must extend your trot. Double bareback maybe asked to switch spots while mounted. A
 bareback pad is allowed to cushion the rider, but there should be NO stirrups and NO girth attached. Double
 Bareback both riders must register in the class. Jackpot means we will give 50% of the entry fees to the winner.

The judge will determine the placement for each class.

Patterns will be posted the morning of the show at registration.

We will not penalize a well-turned-out rider wearing a polo or show shirt. Helmets are required for riders under the age of 18 when riding anywhere on the grounds. Proper riding boots are a must. Both sides of the release form must be signed.
