The Gathering and Welcome

Call to Worship and Introit

We walk these forty days; with You, we fast and pray.
We reflect, confess and return to You. Guide us in Your way.

Time of Confession and Grace

Creator God, You made the earth; and saw that it was good. We behold the vastness of the sky and seas, the majesty of the mountains and valleys, the beauty of the trees and flowers and vegetation. You have asked us to care for this creation, to serve You and praise You by loving all You have made. But we have failed Your call. Instead of seeing Your creation as a gift, we have viewed it as our own possession. Instead of tending and nurturing it, we have abused it and caused great harm. And although our hands may have not caused the harm, we have adopted a lifestyle of comfort and have remained silent to its abuse. **Lord, have mercy.**

Creator God, You made the earth and all that is in it; and saw that it was good. Our lives have been enriched by the birds that fly and the fish that swim and all the animals that walk or creep on the land. You have asked us to care for this creation, to serve You and praise You by loving all You have made. But we have failed Your call. Instead of taking responsibility for the care of the animal kingdom, we have once again looked upon them as possessions and trophies to hang upon our wall. We have stood by as others treated them horribly, or slaughtered them as sport. **Christ, have mercy.**

Creator God, You made the earth, and all that is in it, and created us in Your own image; and saw that it was good. But we have struggled to understand what it means to be made in Your image. The totality of Your love and compassion and hope is expressed in our diversity, in shades and tones of many colors, in the sounds of many languages, in traditions and experiences spread around the earth. You have asked us to care for this creation, to serve You and praise You by loving all You have made. But we have failed Your call. Instead of celebrating our diversity, we have used it to divide us and to build walls between us. We have failed to care for one another. We have forgotten what it is like to be part of your family and have created a world of 'us' versus 'them'. **Lord, have mercy.**

The Lord God made a covenant with Noah, and God keeps that covenant with us. Our God of the rainbow promises life and hope and joy and peace. Our God of love forgives us and is ready to restore us. Our God will help us to do better, one step at a time, just the way Noah built the ark one cubit at a time. Thanks be to God.

Scripture Lesson

Genesis 6:11-14/ 7:17-19/ 8:6,17-21

Now the Earth was corrupt in God's sight, and the earth was filled with violence. And God saw that the earth was corrupt; for all flesh had corrupted its ways upon the earth. And God said to Noah, "I have determined to make an end of all flesh, for the earth is filled with violence because of them; now I am going to destroy them along with the earth. Make yourself an ark of cypress wood; make rooms in the ark, and cover it inside and out with pitch. / The flood continued forty days on the earth; and the waters increased, and bore up the ark, and it rose high above the earth. The waters swelled and increased greatly on the earth; and the ark floated on the face of the waters. The waters swelled so mightily on the earth that all the high mountains under the whole heaven were covered; / At the end of forty days, Noah opened the window of the ark that he had made. / Bring out with you every living thing that is with you of all flesh—birds and animals and every creeping thing that creeps on the earth—so that they may abound on the earth, and be fruitful and multiply on the earth." So Noah went out with his sons and his wife and his sons' wives. And every animal, every creeping thing, and every bird, everything that moves on the earth, went out of the ark by families. Then Noah built an altar to the Lord, and took of every clean animal and of every clean bird, and offered burnt offerings on the altar.
