Outdoor Dining Guidelines

Due to Santa Clara County Law:

- We encourage our guests to make reservations online or call in advance to confirm outdoor seating/serving capacity to prevent crowding while customers wait for their tables.
- Every guest in your party will be screened for temperature and symptoms upon arrival for outdoor dining. Every guest will be asked to use hand sanitizer, and to wear a face covering when not eating or drinking. We have the right to cancel reservations for individuals/parties with symptomatic guests.
- We only allow up to 6 guests at a single table to a household unit. Every guest sharing a table must be from the same household. All members of your party must be present before seating and will be seated at the table at one time only in accordance with Santa Clara County COVID-19 outdoor dining guidelines.
- **FACE COVERINGS ARE REQUIRED. FACE COVERINGS MUST BE WORN WHILE NOT EATING OR DRINKING.** Face coverings must be worn at all times indoors. Guests must wear face coverings while: waiting in line, going to or from their table, ordering their meals or interacting with a server or staff, seated at a table and waiting for food/drink or a check to arrive, after meal and beverages have been consumed in accordance with Santa Clara County COVID-19 outdoor dining guidelines to facilitate prevention of COVID-19.
- Frequently wash your hands with soap for at least 20 seconds, use hand sanitizer and please avoid touching your face.
- Please practice physical distancing at all times.
- Please raise your hand when you need our servers to come to your table.
- We do not leave after-meal mints, candies, snacks, or toothpicks for customers at this time. If you would like any of these items, please let our server know.

If guests do not comply with these guidelines, we have the right to refuse service.
