FIBER ARTS COMPETITION

Deadline for entry 5:45 pm,
Friday, Nov. 8, 2019

The Fiber Arts Competition is open to all fiber artists using 60% wool. If you wish to enter, please read the rules carefully. Judging will occur Friday night after hours behind closed doors. The Competition will be on display during Kid 'n Ewe Saturday and Sunday. Submissions must be picked up on Sunday between 2pm - 4pm with your ticket stub.

Download the completed entry form and bring with the entries when dropping off on Friday at the Suzoo's Wool Works Booth between 10 am - 6 pm. We need a full description of your entry; title, category, techniques of construction, breed of animal (if applicable), and artist name. All entries must be tagged with the above information prior to delivering.

Entries can include 3-D sculptures and needle felted art with the back visible for judging. They could include wall hangings, pillows, rugs, etc. made of 60% wool. All should be of own design and execution. Items will be judged on artistic merit, originality, creativity, attention to detail

and craftsmanship as well as use of wool fibers. Depending on entries it will be the judges discretion to make categories

In the spirit of creativity, all pieces must be hand crafted/made.

Items entered that are felted do not need to have an accurate wool analysis done because only wool fibers will felt. You must submit yarn or fabric for testing. The wool fabric items must be tested as in the clothing contest.

Fiber Arts Rules

- Articles must be 60% natural fiber (excluding commercial warp or canvas)
- Entries may be hand knit, hooked, woven, crocheted, felted, or free form*.
- The articles must have been completed in 2019.
- There will be First and Second in each category and an overall Best in Show.
- Judging will be separate for adults and youth. Youth are considered up to 16 years. Adults are 17 and older.

Each entrant is allowed three entries per category. For category details, please visit www.kidnewe.com

*Other refers to collage, tapestry, wool appliqué, tating, or other art inspired by natural fiber.

**Natural fiber implies cotton, linen, wool, mohair, camelid, angora, etc.
