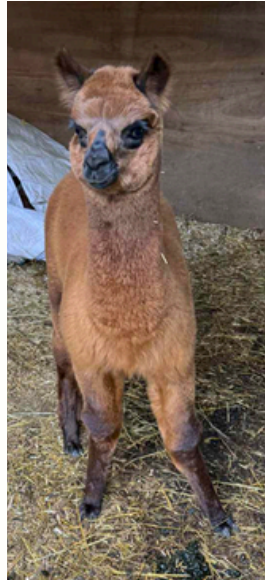
A word from our founder:
