

I can't thank you enough for your time today. Your wisdom, guidance, and calm, informed approach provided exactly the kind of support and relief I've been searching for, and for the first time in a long while, I feel like I'm no longer facing this entirely on my own.

The past three years have been deeply challenging. I've felt helpless so often, navigating complex systems with little clarity, trying to advocate for my son in environments where understanding and support have been painfully lacking. The dismissiveness from schools and teachers, and the constant need to justify his needs, has left me emotionally exhausted and, at times, completely broken. My own mental health has taken a hit, and the toll this has taken on both of us has been heartbreaking.

To have someone not only understand the system, but also truly listen, empathise, and offer clear, actionable advice means more to me than I can fully express. Having this support, finally, feels like a lifeline.
