The Collection System is a vacuum sewer system with 1570 valve pits in operation with 10 inch 8 inch, 6 inch and 4 inch main lines and four main pump stations. Stations 2, 3 and 4 have two vacuum pumps and two sewage pumps. Station 1 has four vacuum pumps and two sewage pumps. The Town has a back-up generator with auto transfer switches at all four pump stations in order to provide service during power outages. We also have 2 diesel powered pumps and a vacuum truck for emergency use. We have 6 spare vacuum pumps and spare sewage pumps for all four pump stations.

System Performance Year 2020-2021

- The Town received its wastewater collection permit on June 26, 2006.
- The only requirement of the permit not fulfilled for 2020 was this annual report to customers.
- The Town completed pump station 3 upgrades in Feb 2020, total cost \$2,145,523.25
- The public works department added 20 new valve pits for new homes.
- The public works department have not experienced any sanitary sewer overflows.

The public works department would like to remind customers to not pour grease fats or oil from cooking down the drain they are the leading cause of overflows and line blockages.

Replace broken clean out caps.


