Budget Schedule 2024

- Since late Jan thru mid June BOC held series of a dozen workshops to facilitate development of the FY 25 Budget
- 29 May Manager's Budget Message published
- 18 June Budget Public Hearing and Consideration
- 1 July Budget Adopted No Later Than

Budget Schedule 2024

- Draft Budget Ordinance reviewed by BOC last Wednesday 12 June
 - directed deletion of the Detective position
- Revenue accruals also updated for Harbor Acres Canal Dredging to include recent grant reimbursement

- Funds 1 LWF sidecast dredging event

Highlights BPART

- Funds town portion of the USACE CSDR study
- Funds engineering and permitting required for future Town shovel ready beach projects
- Transfers \$94,500 to Beach/Inlet CRF

Highlights Canal Dredging

 Sets forth capability to execute canal dredging in the three canal districts

Funds disposal site policy development and permit update requirements

Highlights Capital Reserve Funds

- Water and Sewer Capital Reserve Funds established by act of the General Assembly
 - Home for System Development Fees- to be used for W&S capital expansion
 - Estimated accruals @ \$244,674 (W) & \$579,461 (S)
- Beach & Inlet Capital Reserve Fund
 - Accrues to \$2,375,766
