The Parks and Recreation Advisory Board (PRAB) of the Town of Holden Beach, North Carolina met at 2:00 p.m. on Thursday, May 7, 2026 in the Town Hall Public Assembly. Present were: Chair Candace Vick, Vice Chair Mike Pearson and Members Peggy Schiavone, Suzannah Tucker, Melanie Champion, and Ray Edwards. Member Grace Bannerman could not attend. Assistant Town Manager Christy Ferguson was also in attendance.

Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 2:00 p.m.

Agenda Approval

Chair Vick asked for agenda approval.

Approval of Minutes

Chair Vick asked for approval of the minutes.

Member Schiavone supplied a correction to her attendance at the previous meeting. She was not in attendance and the minutes indicated she was.

Program and Facilities Update

In a programs update, Assistant Town Manager Ferguson stated that concerts would be beginning Memorial Day weekend and reminded the PRAB they had the 50/50 that weekend. She continued that Beach Rangers will be starting up the week before Memorial Day, May 18th. She also said that Tide Dye will begin June 9th. Times were discussed.

Moving to facilities, Assistant Town Manager Ferguson stated that the basketball goal nearest town hall has been removed because there was an issue with the base being safe. A new template and concrete plate are being assembled. The picnic shelter at the park was treated with an epoxy layer to decrease the slick texture ahead of the splash pad opening later in the month. The pier at Halstead is complete. The stage is moving along at a good pace and is still on schedule per the contract. The Block Q master plan contract will be on the May agenda of the Board of Commissioners.

Member Tucker asked about landscaping outside the bathroom. She also asked about a ribbon cutting for the stage. She stated that the owner of Dockhouse said that when the concerts moved it impacted his business on concert nights. She said he would like to do something around the ribbon cutting so that those that had a hand in getting it going could be included. She said she gave Assistant Town Manager Ferguson the contact information. Member Edwards said they might get involved in the ribbon cutting.

Assistant Town Manager Ferguson also mentioned that the PAR Course sketches from Barrs are in for the start of the fiscal year.
