Not enslaved, but set free! From now on we will be One in Jesus, one in water, baptized and set free. (ELW 453)

This hymn, our Opening, and our Galatians reading (For freedom Christ has set us free. Stand firm, therefore, and do not submit again to a yoke of slavery) are "big picture" words. They remind us who we are, whose we are, and who we're called to be in this world. Paul goes on to talk about how people can be enslaved by "licentiousness, idolatry, strife, jealousy, anger" etc. But God has created us to be above those destructive emotions, to make this world a better place by our actions and our very being. It is a high and holy calling, and with freedom comes responsibility. Deep breath!

The four cases of handbells, about 194 lbs., were packed and shipped UPS to Green Lane, Pennsylvania to be refurbished by the company that made them Schulmerich. Refurbishment includes disassembling, cleaning, replacing broken parts, new clappers, new discs, new handles, polishing, tension adjustments, tuning and more. St. Mark's bought these bells in 1986, and there is no record of any professional maintenance since. This maintenance is necessary and costly.
