The Reach Home in Bapatla, India provides all basic life needs (food, clothing, shelter, education, Christian education, medical needs, and loving care from teachers and staff) for approximately 100 children.

Your gift of \$365.00 (\$1 per day) will sponsor a child for an entire year.

Once your registration information and initial payment is received, you will receive information about the child you will be sponsoring. Sponsors will receive photos and letters from the child. Sponsors are also encouraged to write to their child. Please keep in mind that while some children stay at Reach Home their entire childhood, some are there for a shorter time. If your child leaves, you will be notified and reassigned a new child.



In 1982, Victor Paul was studying at Luther Seminary in St. Paul, MN. His wife Kusuma and their three small children were also here from India. This was the beginning of God's amazing journey for Kusuma and the children of Bapatla, India. Palmer (visiting students at the Seminary) and Margaret Rauk and their children befriended the Indian couple. After Victor and Kusuma returned to India their friends came to visit them. There they found Kusuma's parents caring for three orphaned children although they had little money. They had faith that God would provide. When the Rauk's returned home from their visit they had a passion to help the children they had seen there. A plea to their church members at St. Mark's Lutheran Church, No. St. Paul, MN was accepted by many people willing to help. With the support of members of the church, they started to take in children, providing food, shelter, clothing, schooling, health care and the love of lesus Christ.



Almost 30 years later, Palmer and Margaret's children continue the legacy that their parents cared so deeply about. Dr. Dan Rauk does a dental clinic when he visits the orphanage to maintain good dental health. Angel Mogren and Pete Mogren lead teams of missionaries and medical professionals to Bapatla to insure the children are healthy and well cared for. They also oversee the funding of the orphanage. St. Mark's Lutheran in St. Paul, MN, administers all of the sponsorships, donations, and memorial funds.
