Listen to a program of Lenten-themed stories and music transmitted through your FM radio (97.9 FM). Additionally, there will be stations positioned throughout the gathering space where we invite you to take some time for personal reflection as an ending to our Lenten journey.

You may participate from the warmth and comfort of your car or gather safely around one of several small bonfires. Pre-packaged goodies and hot chocolate will be served. If you wish to spend some time at the stations or by the fire, we must follow safety guidelines. Masks must be worn and please respect each other by maintaining physical distancing of 6 feet.

April 4: Easter Sunday (10:00 am): In-person outdoor worship service with Holy Communion, in addition to a pre-recorded Easter service available online.

Pre-registration is currently closed for Maundy Thursday. **There is still time to register ahead of time to attend the Good Friday services. Registration closes at 8:00 pm Thursday.*

Attendance is limited to 50 people, masks must be worn, and seating will be assigned. Thank you for your understanding.
