The parking lot project, initially slated for June, has been shifted to late July early August. This change will allow for several diseased trees to be removed from around the west lot without risking damage to fresh asphalt. The trees in question re scheduled to be removed in mid-July.

Members needed to serve on Call Committee

The Nominating Committee is looking for 8-10 members of the congregation to serve on a Call Committee. This committee will be tasked with identifying candidates for our pastoral staff.

The Call Committee's primary objective will be to identify candidates for the lead pastor position. Our current associate pastor, Pastor David Bjorklund, has indicated he is willing to be considered for the lead pastor role. As internal candidate, Pastor David would initially be the only candidate for consideration.

Should the Call Committee put Pastor David's name forward, there would be special congregational meeting to vote on Pastor David for lead pastor. Should the congregation choose not select Pastor David for the lead pastor role, the committee would then move on to consider other candidates for the position. If the congregation were to choose Pastor David as lead pastor, then the Call Committee would transition to identifying candidates for the associate pastor position.

Special Congregational Meeting – July 10

Council President Mike Ericson and Pastor David Bjorklund have called a special congregational meeting to be held on July 10, 2022 following morning worship. The purpose of this meeting is to approve the Mission Investment Fund loan for our parking lot renovation, and to approve expenditures to replace the sanctuary HVAC system. Both of these projects have been reviewed and approved by the Altar Care: We need about 5 volunteers to set up Property and Finance Committees, and the Church Council. These will be the only items on the agenda for this special meeting. A quorum of 100 members is required for the meeting. July 10th is also the morning of our outdoor worship service and picnic. We'll have a lively service with communion and two baptisms. Immediately after the service we'll have our brief congregational meeting and afterwards we'll break out the food to feast and have some fun!
