On September 13, we held our first in person worship service in 6 months! It was so good to see one another again!

Thanks to Karen Biedermann for this synopsis of the morning:

Everyone involved was very pleased with the event! We had about 90 parishioners in attendance. About 1/3 stayed in their cars, and 2/3 brought chairs and sat socially distanced in the front parking lot. We had a team set up the parking lot ahead of time to control traffic flow (shout out to the bright orange chairs from Rees Hall that served as great makeshift traffic cones!). As people drove in, two teams welcomed them, directed them where to park, and handed out single serve communion kits. Gary Martin set up an FM transmitter for those staying in their cars, and people that used the radio station through their car radios said the sound quality was great. We had a very nice worship service led by Pastor Mary and Cory, with music from Missy Lillie, Nancy Lacroix and Tom Michel. The group did a great job social distancing and staying masked, and post service people stayed to chat and help clean up.

As part of God's Work, Our Hands Sunday, prayer shawls were available for drop off and pick up, there was a drop off for the food shelf (and the table was full at the end of the morning!), good work was done on the grounds by Rees Hall and the Christian Ed Supply Room was cleaned out!

All in all, it was a wonderful event! For September 27, we will plan on having more spots available for people that want to enjoy the service from their cars.
