Outdoor Worship Service with Communion – Sunday, September 27 at 10:00 am

That's right! We had such a great time coming together for worship two weeks ago...we're doing it again one more time before the weather becomes too unpredictable. If you didn't make it last time, here's how it works: participants may bring their own lawn chairs or stay in their cars. The service will be broadcast through an FM transmitter, so you will be able to tune your car radios to hear it. Everyone will be asked to wear masks and maintain appropriate physical distancing. A pre-taped service (different from the outdoor service) will also be available online for those unable to make it in-person. 
The complete meeting minutes are available in the church office after they are approved at the following meeting. The next Council meeting is scheduled for October 15 at 6:30 pm.
