### **Music Notes**

Tom Paulson, Director of Music & Worship

Female composers of classical music seem to be few and far between; I only remember studying the music of one in college or grad school. Is this because there were no women composers, or were the opportunities available to men composers not available to women? I tend to think the latter.

So it was very fun to come across the music of Elizabeth-Claude Jacquet de la Guerre (1664-1729); she composed the music Suzanne, Jennifer, Karin and I are playing today for worship. She was born about 20 years before J.S. Bach, and wrote and performed music for the Sun King, Louis IV of France. She was considered one of the great artists of her time, one whose feats as a composer and performer surely merited enduring recognition. However, since her death she has been mostly forgotten, until the last 10 years or so.

In 1977 St. Mark's called our first female pastor, Joy Bussert. I remember how trailblazing that was for my home congregation, in 1984! So kudos to St. Mark's. In today's reading from Galatians, Paul writes "... let us not grow weary in doing what is right ... let us work for the good of all." St. Mark's surely did what was right in 1977, working for the good of all, and continues to try to do so today. In fact it is the heart of our mission to love God, and love our neighbor.

I think we are doing what is right by learning the music of this great woman, and bringing it back to life and into worship. She merits enduring recognition. I pray that she is an encouragement to each of us to be the person God created us to be. As Paul writes in Romans, don't let the world squeeze you into its mold, let God remake you from within.
