"Nothing in nature lives for itself. The rivers do not drink their own water; the trees do not eat their own fruit; the sun does not shine on itself and flowers do not spread their fragrance for themselves. Living for others is a rule of nature. We are all born to help each other. No matter how difficult it is. Life is good when you are happy; but much better when others are happy because of you." (Pope Francis?)

I came across this quote on Facebook 3 years ago or so, and was so taken by it I set it to music in one morning. After doing a little more research, I began to realize that these words didn't really originate with Pope Francis, but are more credibly Hindi. Since Francis often uses them in his speeches and sermons, he is sometimes given credit for them. That is one of the problems with social media. Nevertheless, these words strike me as true.

And they are good words to ponder as we consider our Stewardship theme, A Place at the Table. Who is invited to Christ's table? Who should be excluded? Who has been excluded and so needs special attention? What is our role in making this world a better place, a Beautiful City? Perhaps our faith calls us to Build a Longer Table, Look Who Gathers at Christ's Table, and hear their stories.
