No election of posts was required at this point. The Chairman asked if all the Councillor was prepared to continue in the role and all agreed.

669 Summary of Police Activity

PC Reid reported that in 2012 there had been 2 reported crimes in Brown Candover which was the same number as in 2011 and a drop on 2010 when there had been 7. The 2 crimes were the theft of the lightning conductor from the church and a house burglary in November. There were a number of other incidents in Brown Candover including a door to door salesman working without license, a minor road traffic accident, a dog killing pheasants and a suspicious 4 x 4 pulling into a drive at night with no lights on.

In Chilton Candover, there was 1 crime, which was a drop from 3 in both 2011 and 2010. The only crime was a robbery at 4:30am from a shed where a quad bike and trailer were taken. There were a small number of other incidents including 2 minor road traffic incidents, one involving a deer, suspicious people seen at Bugmore Hill and a false burglary alarm.

The Chairman and Council thanked PC Reid for all his work in the community over the last year.
