750 Summary of Activity

The Parish Council had worked on the following topics during 2013/14:-

- Discussed a Local/Neighbourhood Plan
- Training on Localism
- Lengths man role
- Website – continued issues with training which have now been sorted and the site is being updated
- More books were sort for the library and received
- The local rural walks were to be documented and put on the website (on-going)
- Flooding issues
- Jubilee remaining funds £400 and using it to buy a bench
- Threat of Shop closure

751 Planning applications

There have been 10 planning applications of which 6 have been approved and the remaining 4 are awaiting decision, they are:-

- Gates from the car park to the field at Woolpack Inn – on-going
- Wind Farm at Woodmancott – on-going
- Math Farm – converting old Diary to shooting lodge – approved

- Moth House – Retrospective application for roadway and change of site and size of outbuilding – on-going
- Yew Tree Cottage – tree work – approved
- 32 Brown Candover – extension – original granted but amended plans awaiting decision
- 1 Chilton Candover – conservatory - approved
- 18-21 Moth Cottages – tree work - approved
- 2 Old School House – tree work - approved
- 44 Brown Candover – tree work - approved

752 Financial summary

During 2013/14 the Parish Council accounts were as follows:-

- £4,937 income from Basingstoke and Deane
- £324.13 additional income from VAT refund and bank interest
- £4,777.99 payments made
- Opening balance £8,568.26
- Closing balance £9,051.40

This meant that the Parish Council spent £483.14 less than the income for the year.
