

Training of health care workers on the conduct of cervical screening and clinical colposcopy.

MODEL OPERANDI.

ARGUMENT ALGORITHM 1:

Involves screening of the cervical cases. This is through "see, treat and follow up approach".

Components include;

In house Screening,

- **VIA** [Visual inspection with acetic acid].
- VILI [Visual Inspection with Lugol's iodine].
- Clinical Colposcopy.
- Pap Test.
- NAT

Out house screening,

• **HPV** Self-Test kits.

ARGUMENT ALGORITHM 2.

Contains components and tools of diagnosis Components include;

- Colposcopy Devices with green light component
- Full diameter Speculum.
- Cone Biopsy/Punch devices.
- Thermocycler.

The purpose of this argument is to classify the type of the cervical lesions involved. It's the definitive form of the cervical cancer diagnosis.

Classification is basically routed from **VIA/VILI** and or Colposcopy Findings and the swede scoring system. Other observations may be obtained from self-test HPV kits analysis and the pap tests. Types of the lesions for treatment at the POC [Point Of Care] based on Colposcopic findings.



ARGUMENT ALGORITHM 4. Follow up.

Here the use of the tracking devices for any patient found to have CIN 1, CIN 2 and CIN 3. In our model, we use a **SMARD CARD TECHNOLOGY** called **AFYA SMARTMETRIC CARD™** to store patient data under a secured fingerprint mode. The information about the patient is in form of the bio data, cervical images via colposcopy examination. This is then sent for a copy to our secure remote server. Every visitation for review, a patient is needed to produce this card and access is only through fingerprint reader and identification. The clinician then can compare the images for the first day of examination, second revisits and any consecutive visits of treatment and progress evaluated. This is a good prognostic and qualitative measure of the process of cervical treatment using any of the **Argument 3** above.



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ARGUMENT ALGORITHM 5.

Survivorship with group therapy sessions and life activities are crucial. Nutrition, spiritual and exercises prays a key role in healing.



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TAKING CARE OF SURVIVORSHIP PROGRAM WITH **ORPHANS AND VULNERABLE CHILDREN [OVC]** THROUGH THE TRUST FUND.



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CHALLENGES:

- Massive deficiency of funding to cover up the 8 regions direly in need of our services total of 47 Counties.
- Chargeable high cost of shipping of donated medical devices from abroad and delayed clearance of these devices from the port of entry and thus attracting more charges.
- Lack of co-ordination from the local government in allocation of facilities that can be used as screening centres
- Untrained, in competent or poorly trained screening/colposcopy team delaying establishment of colposcopy services in already set free screening centres. This calls for more funding to provide this much needed training in health care workers.
 - Lack of good models of quality specified disposable vaginal speculums /proctoscopes available in the country. There is a high influx of low quality, dangerous, Non-FDA/CE marked speculums that does not work with our standard. Our colposcopy screening requires a wide Multi petalled" speculum with self-lighting torch.
