1. Disclosure Statement. Please read this form; Each person attending the session is required to sign this form. I encourage you to keep a copy of this form for your own records.
2. Release of Information & Privacy Practices. Each person needs to be included on the form and must sign.
3. Information form and Personal Background form. For individuals, only 1 form is needed. For couples, please *each* complete *your own form* in its entirety. If language, comprehension, or other issues exist that make it difficult for you to complete your own form, please call me to discuss this. Ultimately, your responses will help me get to know you and I'll use this information in the report I write. There are no wrong answers; please answer honestly for yourself!

As you print the forms, I encourage you to print on both sides of paper in order to reduce paper use. Please bring all 3 handouts with you to our upcoming appointment. You can plan on meeting with me for 60 minutes so we can complete the evaluation component as well as discuss some of the emotional and mental intricacies of using a donor.

Often incoming clients feel concerned about the "evaluation" aspect of this session and rightly comment on the inequity they experience compared to others who have no trouble conceiving. While the evaluation is an important piece of our meeting according to the American Society of Reproductive Medicine standards, I hope you'll find our time together useful to highlight some important discussions and ethical considerations of the treatment you plan to pursue. We can also use our time together to answer some of your questions about donors, telling children about a donor, etc. I look forward to meeting with you!
