RULES:

Spaces are limited, so please do not commit if you cannot follow through with a tree. Timelines are VERY important. Please make sure to follow them all.

Do not place ANYTHING on the walls.

Please do not touch the trees, ornaments, or decorations of others.

No tables, easels or anything else can be placed at or near your tree, everything should be attached to your tree. If your tree is too large to install in the spot you are assigned, please ask for assistance.

Trees must be securely placed.

Please bring all the supplies needed to assemble and decorate your tree, including carts, extension cord while decorating, ladder or step stool, cleanup supplies, and broom and dustpan. (Before the opening day, Town will install extension cords for all trees)

You will need to incorporate your tree name into the design ON your tree. No additional signage can be placed on the walls or on the floor. (The Town will install a number at your spot for voting purposes).

YOU must take ONE (1) picture of your completed tree and submit it to <u>WilliamstonForms@gmail.com</u> for online voting. If you do not submit a photo, your tree will only have a name and number for online voting.
