BONNIE & LONNIE - These two are brother and sister, possibly twins. They are large people and dress alike in truck driver jeans, T-shirts and vests. Keys and wallets on long chains, trucker boots and similar haircuts and ball caps. Each one has been given half of what it takes to get by in this world, but each one has also been given the other.

GLORIA – 60s. Not unlike Brenda from The Valley but, having been married to Hubba, she is more realistic and sarcastic. Emotional; quick to temper and tears, alligator tears but tears none the less

RAY DON - Juliano's son, mid-to-late twenties, divorced. Suburban cowboy look but has never been on a horse or seen a cow close up. Most likely works in a plumbing supply store or behind the counter at NAPA. Ray Don never has a kind word for anybody or anything.

NEUTRAL CHARACTERS
