**CONCERT BAND:** For woodwind, brass and percussion students, with at least one year of playing experience on their instrument.

**BEGINNING JAZZ BAND:** For first- or second-year instrumental students who are interested in learning to play jazz styles of music.

**ADVANCED JAZZ BAND:** For third- or fourth-year instrumental students who are interested in learning to play jazz styles of music.

**BEGINNING INSTRUMENTAL LESSONS:** For students interested in learning an instrument to play in the JFK Middle School band or orchestra in the fall.

**STRING ORCHESTRA:** For violin, viola, cello, and bass students, with at least one year of playing experience on their instrument.

**WORLD DRUMMING:** Open to all students. Drums will be provided in class.

**BEGINNING PIANO:** Open to all students with no (or limited) experience playing piano. Keyboards will be provided.

**BEGINNING GUITAR:** Open to all students with no (or limited) experience playing guitar. Guitars will be provided.
