To the students and parents/guardians of the class of 2026,

Hello and welcome to Enfield High School! We're excited to welcome you to our school community! We have so much to offer here, and we're looking forward to sharing it all with you! We will be holding freshman orientation over the course of two days. Students with the last name A-L will have orientation on Friday, August 19, and students with the last name M-Z will meet on Monday, August 22.

Busses will pick students up in the morning and drop them off at the conclusion of orientation. The bus schedule will be available on our website prior to orientation, and an email will be sent out with bus stop information as well.

Returning EPS students who have already been issued iPads by the district will need to bring their old iPad and charger to orientation. At orientation, you will hand in your old iPad and charger, be issued a new iPad and charger, and have the opportunity to purchase insurance on your new device for the 2022-23 school year. Orientation will run from 7:26 AM to 11:30 AM. At orientation, students will meet our building administrators, district coordinators, take a tour of the building, and learn about the many fun and enriching curricular and extra-curricular activities that EHS has to offer. Rising 9th graders will work with current student leaders, who will assist them with activities throughout the day and answer any questions they may have. We are also hopeful that students will be able to receive and become familiar with their schedules at orientation.

In summary:

- Busses will be provided to and from school both days
- Students who do not ride a bus may be dropped off between 7:15 and 7:26, and may be picked up between 11:35 and 11:45
- Masks will be optional
- Lunch will not be served, but there will be a special treat at the end!

Preparing your EPS-issued iPad to hand in

- Locate your iPad, charger, and charger cord. During freshman orientation you will turn in your iPad, charger, and charger cord in the cafeteria and be issued a new device.
- Remove from the iPad any personal items (stickers, etc.) that you have put on and reset the device following the instructions below.
 - o If the iPad has a security pin, remove the pin in Settings
 - o ERASE DATA: Open the iPad and navigate to the setting Icon.
 - Next, select General and scroll down on the right side to the bottom of the page and select "Transfer or Reset iPad"
 - At the next screen, select Erase All Content and Settings
 - If a pin has been assigned, you will need it to confirm that you indeed want to wipe the iPad if not hit continue and then erase will pop up.
 - The iPad will display the Apple Icon as it erases all data. Once you get the hello screen iPad is all set.
- Clean the iPad with a dry paper towel or Clorox Disinfecting Wipe. When doing so, it is important to turn the device off, avoid moisture in any openings (charging point and headphone jack), and ensure that the iPad is wiped with a dry paper towel when complete.
- If you do not have insurance, and need to pay for any lost or damaged items, please consult the list below and bring payment (check payable to Enfield Public Schools)

Charger (regardless of insurance): \$40
iPad: \$400
iPad case: \$100

 Insurance for the 2022-23 school year will cost \$25 (per occurrence). You will be able to pay for this at freshman orientation. A check payable to Enfield Public Schools or My School Bucks is preferred.
