Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s) of current JFK 6th grade students,

Connecticut General Statute 10-206 requires that all school children have a complete health assessment, including a blood test for anemia, three times during their school years. The first time is for the initial entrance into a Connecticut school. Enfield Board of Education Policy 5141.1 requires the other two assessments be done for grade 6 and grade 10.

Both the Statute and Board Policy reflect the growing awareness of the close relationship between good health and good education. Therefore, this health assessment serves a very important function in the learning process.

The best person to do this assessment is your child's healthcare provider. Health assessments are acceptable when done after the last day of 5th grade (June 12, 2020) and before the student begins their first day of 7th grade (September 7, 2021).

Since the start of school in September 2020, several notices have been sent reminding you of the need to have the health assessment done and the completed form turned into the school nurse.

The completed health assessment form MUST be turned in to the school nurse at JFK Middle School before school begins on September 7, 2021. Unfortunately, if the health assessment (physical) is not turned in, your child will not be able to start 7th grade.

If you have already turned the health assessment into the JFK nurses, please disregard this notice.
