
PARENTS AS TEACHERS PROGRAM

APPLE PIE PLAYDOUGH RECIPE

Ingredients:

1 cup flour 1/4 cup salt 1/2 Tbsp. vegetable oil 1 tsp. cream of tartar 1/2 tsp. nutmeg 1tsp. cinnamon 1 tsp. red food color 1 cup water

Instructions

1. In a large pot, combine all dry ingredients and mix well. 2. Add in vegetable oil, food color, and water, stir. 3. Cook over medium heat until the dough pulls away from pot and starts to become dry.

4. Turn off heat, let cool, and knead.

*If the dough feels too sticky, knead in a tablespoon of flour.
