Why is the Jog-A-Thon called the “Huskies Jog-tober”?

The timing is in October and the students will be moving their bodies hopefully in a jog! The students had a great time at last year’s Turkey Trot (Jog-a-Thon held in November) and the PTO and Staff thought this is a great way to continue involving all students in fun activities the PTO can host.

Is fundraising required for my student to participate?

No, fundraising is optional! (What?! We know! We repeat: fundraising is not required!) All students will participate in the Huskies Jog-tober with a classroom goal to fundraise, have fun, and show their team spirit during their turn at Jog-tober. While the PTO is holding the Huskies Jog-tober as a fundraising event, fundraising is optional, the PTO is beyond excited to have an event where ALL students can participate.

What will the donors receive for their donation?

A Thank You!! Thank your donor for supporting you and let them know how Huskies Jog-tober goes. During this jog-a-thon, “purchases” are not made from a catalog like most fundraisers.

When are donations due?

How does the PTO use the funds collected throughout the year?

The Hazardville Memorial School Parent Teacher Organization provides funds for Classroom field trips, Field Day, One Book Three Schools, Teacher Appreciation (throughout the year), Events hosted by the PTO*: Welcome Back Picnic, Turkey Bingo, Trick or Treat Lane/Halloween Party, Winter Concert, Special Persons Dance. The PTO also replenishes the recess carts with equipment such as balls, hoola hoops, jump ropes, for use at recess.

*Not all events will occur this school year due to the pandemic, but we’re trying!
