FAQS:

1) In order to try out, what does my child have to bring?

- Chrv card **with the expiration dates showing**.
- Liability Waiver (step 3) on registration site.
- See the example on: bethedavolleyball.com/register
- Mobile cards or cards that do not have the date and “eligible” QR will not be accepted.
- Please bring these with. Do NOT email them to me as I’m drowning in paperwork.



2) Is there a tryout fee?

- a. No.

3) Are parents allowed in the gym/ can they watch?

- No. And we do not have a place for parents to wait.

4) How many kids are trying out?

- I don't know as this is our first year running a team.
- Other teams typically have anywhere from 20-50 players try out. Expect that it may be competitive.
- We will take a maximum of 15 players per team.

5) My child is a good player. Will she make the team?

- Maybe. We do not have enough spots for everyone.
- We are prioritizing the players who have already played in our program **and** are ready for more intensive training.
- Also, we need to make sure that we have players for all positions.

6) What is BVC offering?

- A U13 travel team that will travel to 2-3 local tournaments.
- A U14/U15 group that will practice three times per week, but likely will not compete against other teams.

7) The team meets three times per week. Can we practice just twice a week?

- No. We will run this as a team. It requires a commitment.
- It would be difficult to practice if players don't come every day.

8) Are there spots available in the clinics?

- Yes, and... spots are filling up fast.
- We have reserved spots for team players.

9) What is the timeline for offers?

- Starting **Oct. 24th** BVC may start making offers to U13 and U14 players.
- U13 and U14 players must make a decision by Oct. 28th at 10PM.
- All U13/ U14 offers not accepted by 10/28 at 10PM will be rescinded.
- Starting **Oct 28th**, BVC may start making offers to U15 players.
- U15 players must make a decision by November 4nd at 10PM.
- All U15 offers not accepted by 11/4 at 10PM will be rescinded.

A. What We're Offering: For 2025-2026, we're offering two options:

- 1) **A U13 competitive team** for players born after July 2012. This team will compete locally in 2 or 3 one-day tournaments.
- 2) **A U14/15 team** (this will likely be non-competitive team but this depends on the age(s) of the participants. If possible, we may try to attend 1-2 tournaments.
- 3) We will work on: conditioning, individual and team skills as well as game play. Players will be assigned and taught positions.

B: Expected Costs and Schedule of Payments:

Payment 1: \$1380	Due by 10/28, 2025 if your child is U13 or U14. Due by 11/4 if your child is U15.	Payment 1 covers the first 12 weeks of the season through end of January.
Fall B*		\$490 (if not already enrolled in a Fall clinic.
Winter and Spring Clinics: \$880	January 3 rd , 2026	This covers both the Winter and Spring sessions (16 weeks: January 3 to May 16)
Payment 2: \$920	February 1, 2026	Payment 2 covers the remainder of the season: February to May.
Tournament fees	Upon registration	Approximately \$50/ tournament
Uniforms (including warm ups and backpack)	Upon delivery	Approximately \$200-300

C. Expectations:

- **Attendance:** Our goal is to have both groups function as teams. We need players to show up to all the practices. Consistent attendance by players is mandatory. If your child has other commitments, or cannot commit to the full season (October to May), please do not apply as this makes team cohesion more difficult.

- **Sportsmanship** is key for both players and parents. Please communicate any concerns directly to the coaches. We want to create a positive, inclusive environment.
- **Referee training and scorekeeper training:** We will need several parents to complete a short training to become referees and scorekeepers when we go to tournaments.
- **Additional Policies for Parents:** Other parents will need to complete the **Code of Conduct/ waiver policy for adults.**

D. Practice Times and Locations:

- Tuesday practices at Tilden MS from 6-8PM.
- Thursday practices at Silver Creek MS from 6-8PM.
- Practice times may shift. We have gym time booked from 6-9.
- Weekend clinics Saturdays at Westland from 3:30-5:30 or Sundays from 6-8PM at Einstein.

E. Refund Policy:

- No refunds except in the case of long-term injury.
- We cannot prorate or refund for missed sessions.

G. How to Accept Your Spot:

1. Email Coach Bublick that you accept the spot and that you understand the costs, expectations, and refund policy.
2. **After Oct. 24th**, in SportsEngine, assign your child to Bethesda Volleyball Club.
3. Make payment 1.
4. Let coach know if you are willing to complete referee or scorekeeper training.
5. Although we hope your child will want to play with us, your child has the right to try out for other teams if he/ she wants. However, **this offer expires at 10PM October 28th**. Please let us know by then.
6. U15 players must let us know by 10pm on Nov. 4th.
