FAQS:

- 1) In order to try out, what does my child have to bring?
 - Chrva card with the expiration dates showing.
 - Liability Waiver (step 3) on registration site.
 - See the example on: bethedavolleyball.com/register
 - Mobile cards or cards that do not have the date and "eligible" QR will not be accepted.
 - Please bring these with. Do NOT email them to me as I'm drowning in paperwork.
- 2) Is there a tryout fee?
 - a. No.
- 3) Are parents allowed in the gym/ can they watch?
 - No. And we do not have a place for parents to wait.
- 4) How many kids are trying out?
 - I don't know as this is our first year running a team.
 - Other teams typically have anywhere from 20-50 players try out. Expect that it may be competitive.
 - We will take a maximum of 15 players per team.
- 5) It says "coed" what does that mean.
 - We will practice on a women's height net and will accept boys who can safely play against girls their age.
 - Boys who qualify for U13 may play on the U13 girls team.
- 6) My child is a good player. Will he/ she make the team?



- Maybe. We do not have enough spots for everyone.
- We are prioritizing the players who have already played in our program **and** are ready for more intensive training.
- Also, we need to make sure that we have players for all positions.

7) What is BVC offering?

- A U13 travel team that will travel to 2-3 local tournaments.
- A U14 group that will practice three times per week, but will not compete against other teams.
- 8) The team meets three times per week. Can we practice just twice a week?
 - No. We will run this as a team. It requires a commitment.
 - It would be difficult to practice if players don't come every day.
- 9) Are there spots available in the clinics?
 - Yes, and... spots are filling up fast.
 - We have reserved spots for team players.

A. What We're Offering: For 2025-2026, we're offering two options:

- 1) A U13 competitive team for players born after July 2012. This team will compete locally in 2 or 3 one-day tournaments.

C. Expectations:
