HELEN LEICHT'S ACOUSTIC SUNDAY

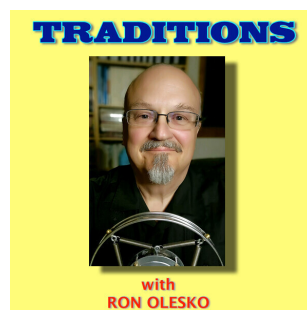
Sunday March 31st at 10am ET / 7am PT
