Saturday Morning To Go "Nowhere"

Folk Music Notebook is thrilled to announce that veteran radio host **Joltin' Joe** will be adding a "weekend" edition of his popular *Radio Nowhere Worldwide* series to our Saturday Morning lineup!

Radio Nowhere Weekend Edition will premiere this Saturday July 27th at 9am Eastern Time / 6am Pacific. It will replace *The Train Wreck*, which was also hosted by Joltin' Joe.

Radio Nowhere has been Joltin' Joe's franchise name and the popularity of the show recognizes Joe's forte. The program offers great contemporary folk music and songwriters from North America and from around the world including Ireland, the UK, Scandinavia, Germany, Austria and more.

Joltin' Joe began *Radio Nowhere* back in 2009 at WMSC in Montclair New Jersey. The success of the series led Joe to create an Internet Radio Channel under the *Radio Nowhere* banner, which ran for several years and was an inspiration for **Folk Music Notebook**. Joe came on board this channel with the series, and it has become one of the most popular shows

that we offer.

In addition to *Radio Nowhere Weekend Edition*, Joltin' Joe will continue to host *Radio Nowhere Worldwide* on Wednesday evenings at Wednesday at 9pm ET / 6pm PT with encore editions Thursday at 5am ET / 2am PT and Friday at noon ET / 9am PT.
