HOME-BASED FOOD SERVICE BUSINESS GUIDELINES

REQUIREMENTS FOR HOME-BASED FOOD SERVICE BUSINESSES IN **SASKATOON**

- Obtain a city of Saskatoon home-based business licence
- Complete an <u>SHA-approved</u> food safety
- Limit home food production to the SHA's "<u>low risk</u>" foods list¹
- Only produce foods not considered "low risk" in an <u>SHA approved</u> commercial kitchen¹
- Properly label food items according to SHA requirements
- Follow other regulations of City of Saskatoon Zoning Bylaws
- Contact the SHA, follow direct guidance, and follow other requirements on the SHA Home Food Processing Fact Sheet¹
- Obtain a Temporary Food Service License from the SHA when selling at unlicenced events^s
- Register the business with the Saskatchewan Corporate Registry if marketing the business under a name other than a personal legal name^{ic}
- Register PST, charge, collect, and remit PST on non-exempt food sales (except Small Trader exemptions)
- Register for a GST account when required, charge, collect, and remit GST on food sales¹¹
- Notify home insurance provider that commercial activity is being conducted in the residence
- Obtain additional municipal licence for mobile food trucks
- Obtain a separate Mobile Vendor License to sell beverages, food or other products from stationary stands, kiosks, or mobile units on public sidewalks⁷

PROHIBITED PRACTICES FOR HOME-BASED FOOD SERVICES BUSINESSES IN **SASKATOON**

- Customer pickups of food orders from residential properties are prohibited³
- Commercial/industrial kitchen equipment usage in residential properties is prohibited³
- Delivery by vehicles with a gross vehicle weight of more than 8,000 kg, or with a total length of more than 6.0 metres to a residential property is prohibited
- Pickups by food delivery service providers from residential properties are prohibited³
- Customer dine-in at a residential property is prohibited
- More than one non-resident person associated with the home based business present at the home based business at any one time is prohibited⁵
- Signage advertising the home-based business is not permitted on the property⁵
