

This will acknowledge your letter of February 20 which has further reference to your 1934 Cadillac.

We have reviewed your comments, Mr. McKelvey, and determined that this vehicle was delivered to Don Lee, Inc., Los Angeles, for Mae West. It is a Model 40 Fleetwood 7-passenger Town Cabriolet. The front compartment was trimmed in black leather and the top was a black leather landau. The body panels, fenders, chassis and wheel were black. The wheel discs were black and the car was equipped with wire wheels. It was equipped with Royal 7.50-17 tires plus two extras. It was also equipped with a goddess hood ornament. Unfortunately, we do not have a list of colors available for the interior and exterior nor the delivery date of the vehicle.
