STEWARDSHIP CORNER

RINCÓN DE LA MAYORDOMÍA

SECOND SUNDAY OF EASTER/SUNDAY OF DIVINE MERCY

In today's first reading, the four activities of the earliest church are introduced to us as priorities of the church: devotion to the teachings of the apostles, communal fellowship, the Eucharist and prayer. The early members of the church saw themselves as devoted stewards of these activities. These were not options. They were the fruits of a genuine conversion to a life in Christ. Sharing in the Eucharist was the most intimate expression of fellowship, while the most common expression of fellowship in the New Testament was that of sharing financial resources – giving. It was not a perfect community, but one that gave evidence of God's active presence in its midst. This early community offers us an excellent example of how to better exercise stewardship in our own parish families.

SEGUNDO DOMINGO DE PASCUA / DOMINGO DE LA DIVINA MISERICORDIA

En la primera lectura de hoy, se nos presentan las cuatro actividades de la Iglesia primitiva como prioridades de la misma: la adhesión a las enseñanzas de los apóstoles, la vida en comunión, la Eucaristía y la oración. Los primeros miembros de la Iglesia se consideraban a sí mismos como administradores entregados a estas actividades. Estas no eran opciones; eran los frutos de una conversión genuina a una vida en Cristo. Participar en la Eucaristía constituía la expresión más íntima de comunión, mientras que la expresión más habitual de comunión en el Nuevo Testamento era la de compartir los recursos económicos: el dar. No se trataba de una comunidad perfecta, sino de una que daba testimonio de la presencia activa de Dios en medio de ella. Esta comunidad primitiva nos ofrece un ejemplo excelente de cómo ejercer mejor la administración en nuestras propias familias parroquiales.

EASTER- A JOYFUL SEASON FOR THOSE WHO ARE THE "LIGHT OF CHRIST"

For those who exercise good stewardship of their Catholic faith, this April is the happiest, most joyful of months for it ushers in the great Easter season – a season of profound hope and joy. During the Easter season, which extends 50 days, from the Easter Vigil Mass of Saturday evening, April 4 to the Vigil Mass of Pentecost Sunday, on Saturday evening, May 23, Christian stewards are exhorted to celebrate and be joyful, for our Savior is with us. In his apostolic exhortation, *Evangelii Gaudium* ("The Joy of the Gospel"), Pope Francis revealed that the best way to live out the joy of Easter is to become a genuine family of faith, an "evangelizing Church that comes out of herself." He urged Catholics around the world to contemplate the mind of Jesus Christ and what it means to be the "light of Christ." From there, Francis believed a spirituality of missionary discipleship could be cultivated that would "help the Church get out of herself" and reach out to those who live in darkness.

PASCUA: UNA TEMPORADA GOZOSA PARA AQUELLOS QUE SON LA «LUZ DE CRISTO».

Para aquellos que ejercen una buena administración de su fe católica, este mes de abril es el más feliz y gozoso de los meses, pues da paso a la gran temporada de Pascua: una temporada de profunda esperanza y alegría. Durante el tiempo pascual —que se extiende a lo largo de 50 días, desde la Misa de la Vigilia Pascual del sábado por la tarde, 4 de abril, hasta la Misa de la Vigilia de Pentecostés, el sábado por la tarde del 23 de mayo—, se exhorta a los administradores cristianos a celebrar y regocijarse, pues nuestro Salvador está con nosotros. En su exhortación apostólica *Evangelii Gaudium* («La alegría del Evangelio»), el Papa Francisco reveló que la mejor manera de vivir la alegría de la Pascua es convertirse en una auténtica familia de fe, una «Iglesia evangelizadora que sale de sí misma». Instó a los católicos de todo el mundo a contemplar la mente de Jesucristo y lo que significa ser la «luz de Cristo». A partir de ahí, Francisco consideró que podría cultivarse una espiritualidad de discipulado misionero que «ayudara a la Iglesia a salir de sí misma» y a tender la mano a aquellos que viven en la oscuridad.

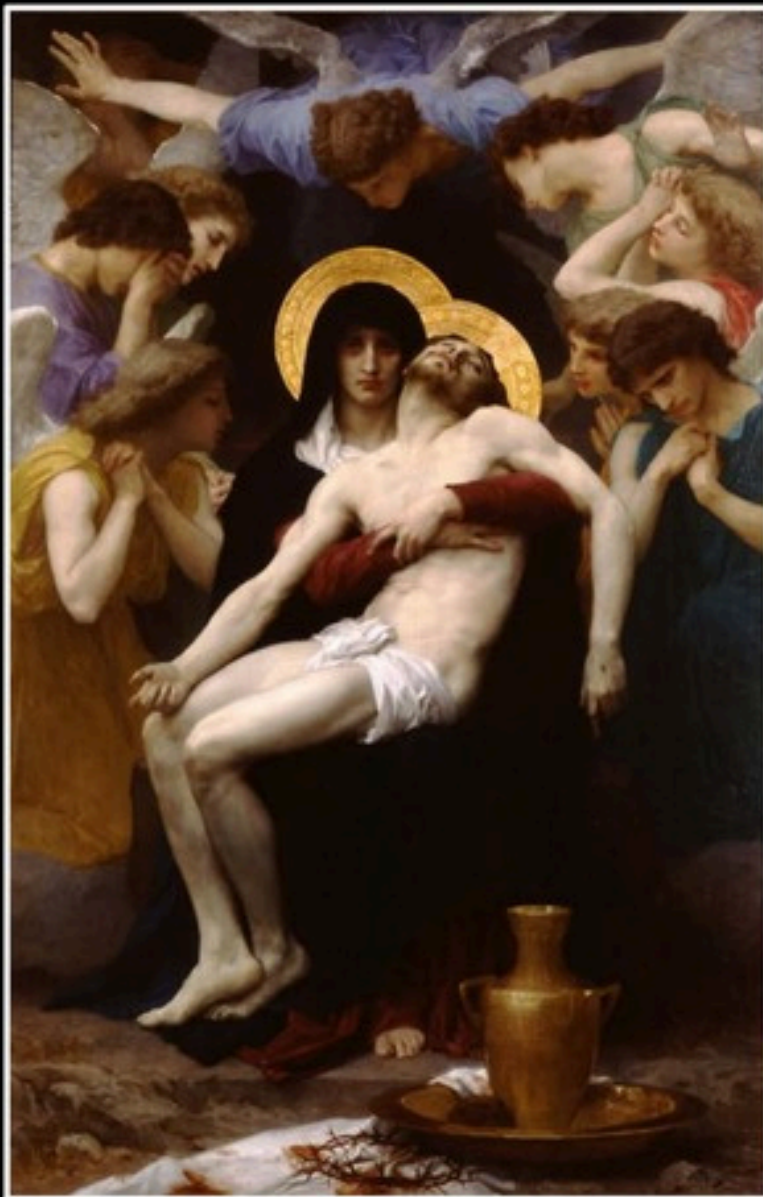
