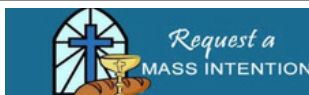

STEWARDSHIP OF OUR SISTERS AND BROTHERS “ON THE STREET”

A few years ago, our late pontiff Pope Francis made one of his off-the-cuff comments that stirred hearts but left a few puzzled. In an interview about refugees, the topic turned to giving to individuals begging on the street. To Christian stewards, especially urban dwellers, this is a common sight: the man at the busy intersection with the sign, the person near the coffee shop jingling change in a cup. Do we give? No matter our response, we are left with a sense of unease, and perhaps even guilt. Pope Francis told the interviewer that it “is always right” to give to the asker, and encouraged us to give with respect and compassion. “Tossing money and not looking into their eyes” is not the behavior of a Christian, he added. Some responded with rather legalist, but none-the-less practical counterarguments. How do we know they won’t buy alcohol or tobacco? Shouldn’t we give instead to charities which assist those on the street? In his typical thoughtful way, Pope Francis addressed these concerns. We all use our money for some guilty pleasures, he said. There’s yesterday’s pastry, or last night’s extra glass of wine. In words we remember Pope Francis speaking on another occasion, “Who am I to judge?” Essentially, giving should come without judgement.

But Pope Francis isn’t issuing rules, but speaking to our attitude. The person begging for our help is just that: a person, with a need for human dignity. And we too have a need, the urge to respond with love to the God who has given us everything. We don’t give because we see the beneficial outcome before our eyes. We give because we have a need to give, because God placed that need in our hearts. Almsgiving is an ancient and inherent part of the Judeo-Christian tradition. If we offer money, or perhaps a bag of snacks which many carry in their cars for such an occasion, do we smile and look someone in the eye? Do we ever stop to chat? Have we offered, not just a donation, but a brief encounter, perhaps offering our first name and asking theirs? Do we treat the poor we encounter as equals, or do we avert our eyes as we pass? Do we understand our own need to give? Christian stewards keep Pope Francis’ words in mind: “In the shoes of the other, we learn to have a great capacity for understanding, for getting to know difficult situations.”

EL CUIDADO DE NUESTRAS HERMANAS Y HERMANOS «EN LA CALLE»

Hace unos años, el Papa Francisco hizo uno de esos comentarios espontáneos que conmueven los corazones, pero que también dejan a algunos desconcertados. En una entrevista sobre los refugiados, la conversación derivó hacia el hecho de dar limosna a quienes piden en la calle. Para los cristianos que viven su fe en la vida cotidiana — especialmente en las ciudades—, esta es una escena habitual: el hombre con un cartel en un cruce muy transitado, o la persona cerca de la cafetería que hace sonar las monedas en un vaso. ¿Damos algo? Sea cual sea nuestra respuesta, nos queda una sensación de inquietud y, tal vez, incluso de culpa. El Papa Francisco dijo al entrevistador que «siempre está bien» dar a quien pide, y nos animó a hacerlo con respeto y compasión. «Arrojar el dinero sin mirar a los ojos» no es propio de un cristiano, añadió. Algunos respondieron con argumentos en contra de corte más bien legalista, aunque no por ello menos prácticos. ¿Cómo saber si no comprarán alcohol o tabaco? ¿No sería mejor donar a organizaciones benéficas que ayudan a las personas que viven en la calle? Con su habitual profundidad, el Papa Francisco abordó estas inquietudes. Todos gastamos dinero en pequeños caprichos, señaló: el dulce que compramos ayer o esa copa de vino de más anoche. En palabras que recordamos haberle oído en otra ocasión: «¿Quién soy yo para juzgar?». En esencia, el acto de dar no debe ir acompañado de juicios.

Sin embargo, el Papa Francisco no está dictando normas, sino apelando a nuestra actitud. La persona que nos pide ayuda es, ante todo, una persona con necesidad de dignidad humana. Y nosotros también tenemos una necesidad: el impulso de responder con amor al Dios que nos lo ha dado todo. No damos porque veamos ante nuestros ojos un resultado beneficioso; damos porque sentimos la necesidad de hacerlo, porque Dios puso esa necesidad en nuestros corazones. La limosna es una parte antigua e intrínseca de la tradición judeocristiana. Cuando ofrecemos dinero —o tal vez una bolsa de comida, algo que muchos llevan en el coche para estas ocasiones—, ¿sonreímos y miramos a la persona a los ojos? ¿Nos detenemos alguna vez a conversar? ¿Ofrecemos, más allá de la donación, un breve encuentro, diciendo nuestro nombre y preguntando el suyo? ¿Tratamos a los pobres que encontramos como a iguales, o desviamos la mirada al pasar? ¿Comprendemos nuestra propia necesidad de dar? Los administradores cristianos tienen presentes las palabras del papa Francisco: «Al ponernos en el lugar del otro, aprendemos a tener una gran capacidad de comprensión, a conocer situaciones difíciles».



REGISTER FOR THE OCIA PROGRAM

The Order of Christian Initiation for Adults or OCIA(formerly RCIA) is a year-long communal process for formal initiation of new members into the Catholic Church. OCIA is process of study, exploration, faith-sharing, and faith formation with specific liturgical rites for seekers and inquirers. Seekers and inquirers are non-baptized adults who desire to be fully initiated into the Roman Catholic Church and/or baptized adult Christians who desire full communion in the Roman Catholic Church. It is open to all adults ages 18+.

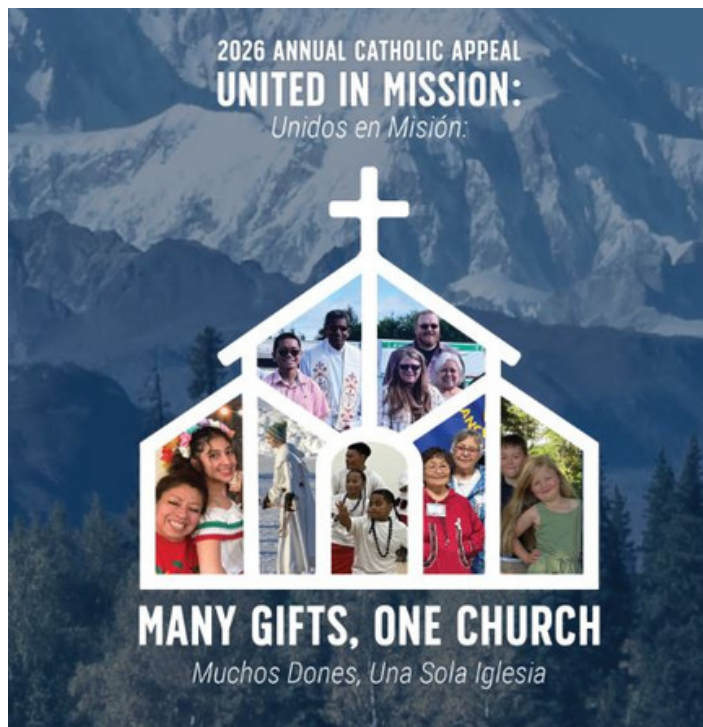

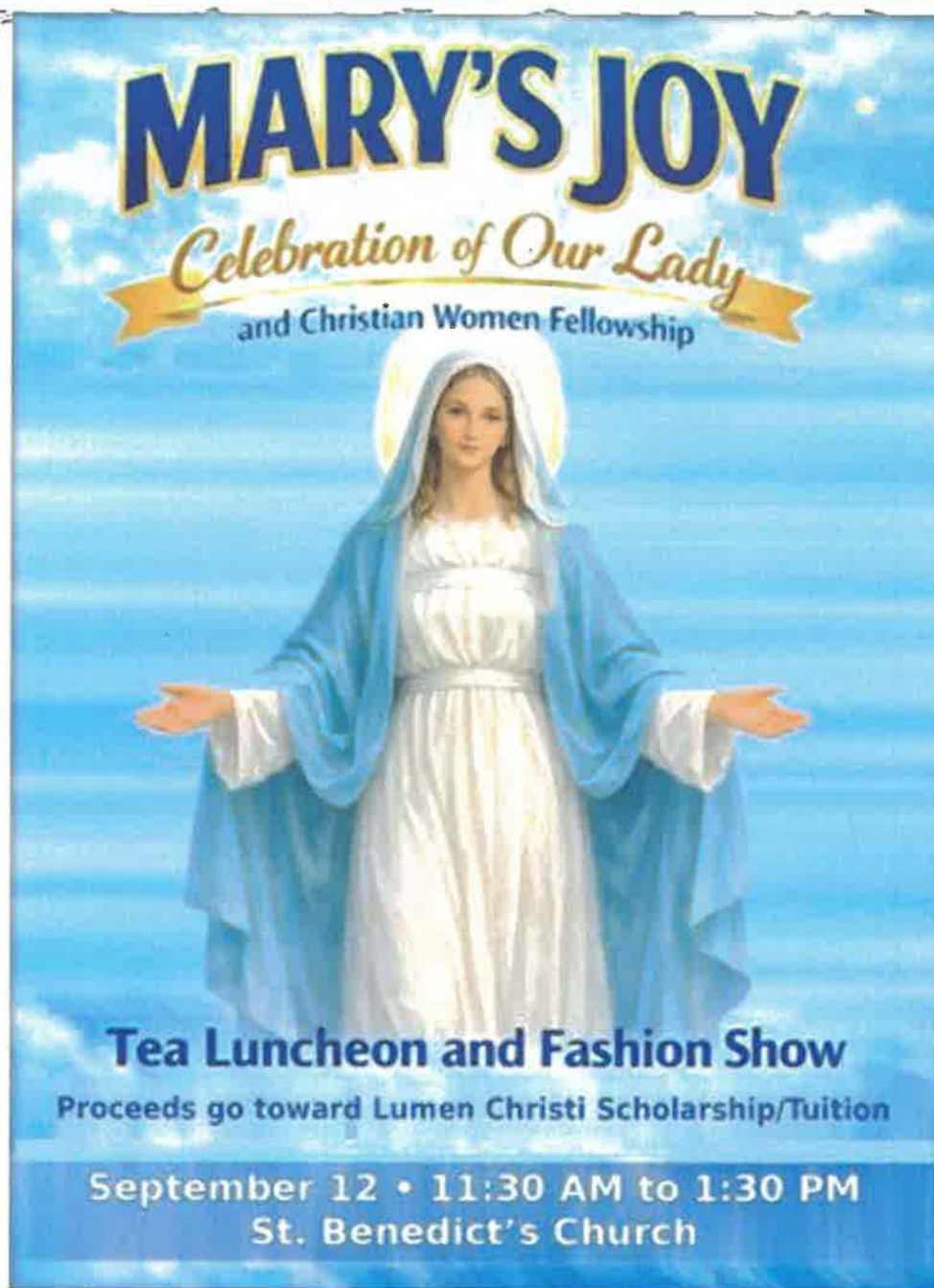

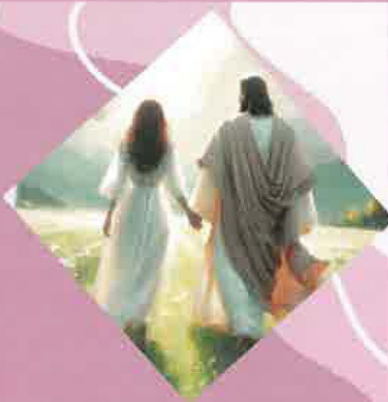
