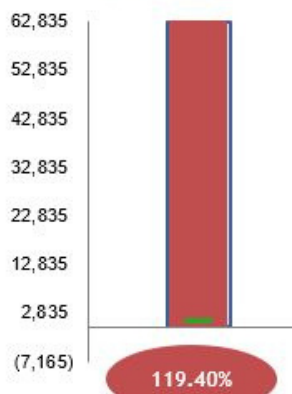

STEWARDSHIP CORNER

RINCÓN DE LA MAYORDOMÍA

In today's Gospel Jesus suggests that his disciples must be prepared to suffer ridicule, persecution and perhaps even death if they are to follow him. Sometimes we may wonder if enduring ridicule and scorn are what we really signed up for when we received the sacraments of initiation. Would we not rather sneak through life as painlessly as possible? Good stewards take their faith seriously and find comfort in the closing words of today's Gospel: "You will be hated by all because of my name but not a hair on your head will be destroyed. By your perseverance you will secure your lives." Let us make it part of our daily prayer routine to ask the Holy Spirit for the courage to act in Jesus' name no matter the consequences.

A previous gospel this month reveals Jesus' encounter with a tax collector named Zacchaeus in the town of Jericho. Described as a short man, Zacchaeus climbed a tree in order to see Jesus pass by. When Jesus saw him, he addressed him by name, and said he wanted to visit his house. The crowd was shocked that Jesus would condescend to being a tax collector's guest. Tax collectors were often corrupt, despised by other Jews as traitors for working for the Roman Empire. Zacchaeus' position would have carried both importance and wealth.

Zacchaeus receives Jesus joyfully, opening his heart and his wallet in a heartfelt expression of generosity. Moved by Jesus' public acceptance of him, Zacchaeus promises to give half his wealth to the poor and to pay fourfold in restitution to anyone he may have defrauded. Those who, like Zacchaeus, sincerely desire to know Christ, will open their eyes and their hearts to the suffering in the world. They show genuine concern for the poor, the marginalized and the oppressed, and they make significant sacrifices of their own time and resources in order to address this suffering. Zacchaeus was hungry to know the Lord, and he made the choice to do his part to help carry out Jesus' mission: to bring good news to the poor (Lk 4:18), and be transformed by the good news himself. Thus, for Saint Luke, Zacchaeus becomes a model of Christian stewardship. Excerpt from ICSC

En el Evangelio de hoy, Jesús sugiere que sus discípulos deben estar preparados para sufrir burlas, persecución e incluso la muerte si quieren seguirlo. A veces nos preguntamos si soportar el ridículo y el desprecio es realmente a lo que nos comprometimos al recibir los sacramentos de iniciación. ¿No preferiríamos acaso pasar por la vida lo más cómodamente posible? Los buenos discípulos toman su fe en serio y encuentran consuelo en las palabras finales del Evangelio de hoy: «Serán odiados por todos a causa de mi nombre, pero ni un solo cabello de su cabeza perecerá. Con su perseverancia salvarán sus vidas». Hagamos que forme parte de nuestra oración diaria pedirle al Espíritu Santo el valor para actuar en nombre de Jesús, sin importar las consecuencias.

Un pasaje del evangelio de este mes narra el encuentro de Jesús con un recaudador de impuestos llamado Zaqueo en la ciudad de Jericó. Descrito como un hombre de baja estatura, Zaqueo se subió a un árbol para poder ver a Jesús pasar. Cuando Jesús lo vio, lo llamó por su nombre y le dijo que quería visitar su casa. La multitud se sorprendió de que Jesús se dignara a ser huésped de un recaudador de impuestos. Los recaudadores de impuestos solían ser corruptos y eran despreciados por los demás judíos, que los consideraban traidores por trabajar para el Imperio Romano. La posición de Zaqueo le habría otorgado tanto importancia como riqueza.

Zaqueo recibe a Jesús con alegría, abriendo su corazón y su cartera en una sincera expresión de generosidad. Conmovido por la aceptación pública de Jesús, Zaqueo promete dar la mitad de sus bienes a los pobres y restituir el cuádruple a quienes haya defraudado. Aquellos que, como Zaqueo, desean sinceramente conocer a Cristo, abrirán sus ojos y sus corazones al sufrimiento del mundo. Muestran una auténtica preocupación por los pobres, los marginados y los oprimidos, y hacen importantes sacrificios de su tiempo y recursos para aliviar este sufrimiento. Zaqueo anhelaba conocer al Señor y decidió contribuir a la misión de Jesús: llevar la buena noticia a los pobres (Lc 4:18) y ser transformado él mismo por esta buena noticia. Así, para San Lucas, Zaqueo se convierte en un modelo de mayordomía cristiana. Fragmento de ICSC

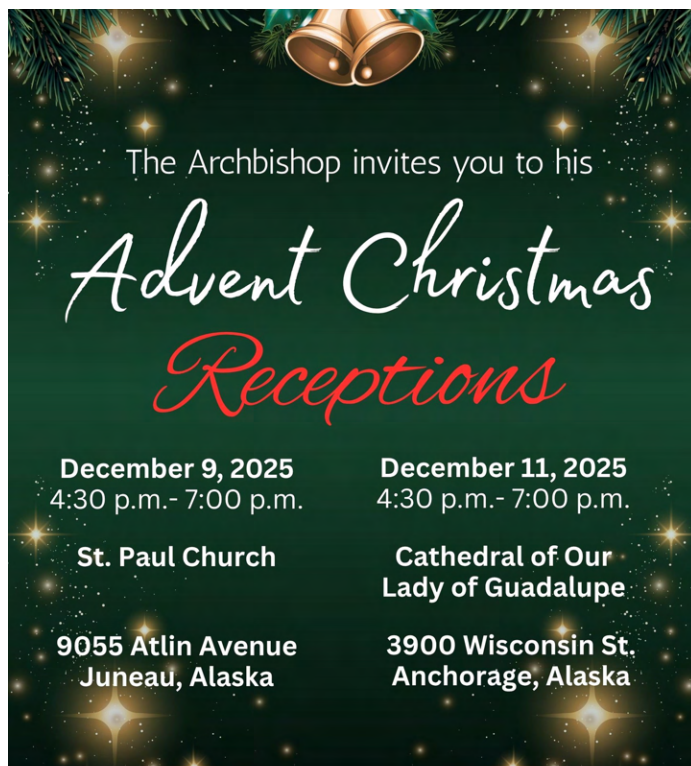

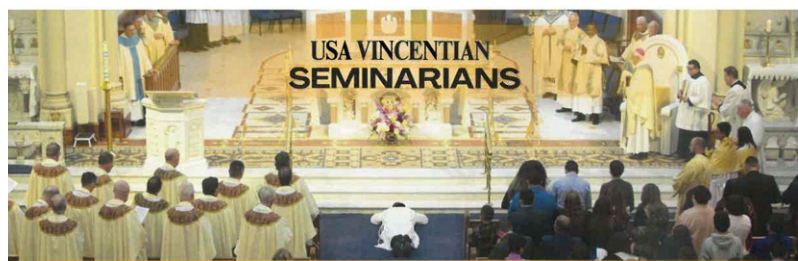
