Dear Church,

It is a small detail, but perhaps significant, that Bartimaeus throws aside his cloak when Jesus calls him. His cloak is not a bad thing; it provides warmth and comfort and even a bit of privacy from prying eyes. But when he needs to move hastily to Jesus, it will trip him up and get in the way so he simply casts it aside. It might be one of very few possessions for this man whose blindness prevents him from working, but he holds it loosely. He does not let attachment to worldly things—even good ones—keep him from responding wholeheartedly to his encounter with Christ. Many of us pray for Jesus' presence and healing much like Bartimaeus did. But we are not always ready to drop what we need in order to be present to the ways he's already working in our lives.

Su manto no es malo; proporciona calidez y comodidad e incluso un poco de privacidad frente a miradas indiscretas. Pero cuando necesita acercarse apresuradamente a Jesús, eso lo hará tropezar y se interpondrá en su camino, por lo que simplemente lo dejará a un lado. Puede que sea una de las pocas posesiones de este hombre cuya ceguera le impide trabajar, pero la conserva sin apretar. No permite que el apego a las cosas mundanas, incluso las buenas, le impidan responder de todo corazón a su encuentro con Cristo. Muchos de nosotros oramos por la presencia de Jesús y su curación, de manera muy similar a como lo hizo Bartimeo. Pero no siempre estamos dispuestos a dejar lo que necesitamos para estar presentes en las formas en que Él ya está obrando en nuestras vidas.

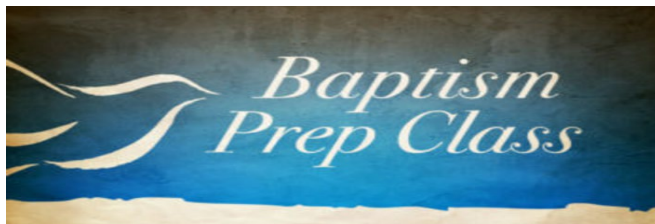
