Dear Church,

The Gospel reading for today is from a section of John known as the "last discourse." Jesus' final words to his disciples during the Last Supper. Within these chapters, we hear Jesus giving instructions to his disciples. Today's portion of this material focuses on the coming of the Holy Spirit, the gift of peace, and Jesus' return to his Father. The tender words in verse 27, "Do not let your hearts be troubled," were also spoken at the very beginning of this discourse. Jesus' return to the Father, after his passion, will bring about a new relationship and a new era, that of the Holy Spirit.

Jesus gives us three awesome promises in today's Gospel: (1) If the disciples (that's us, too) keep Jesus' Word, God will dwell in them; (2) the Holy Spirit will continue teaching them; and (3) they'll have Jesus' own powerful peace. Neither the disciples nor we will be alone in the task of Keeping Jesus' Word. God and the Church are with us.

Querida Iglesia,

La lectura del Evangelio de hoy proviene de una sección de Juan conocida como el "último discurso". Son las últimas palabras de Jesús a sus discípulos durante la Última Cena. En estos capítulos, escuchamos a Jesús dando instrucciones a sus discípulos. La parte de hoy de este material se centra en la venida del Espíritu Santo, el don de la paz y el regreso de Jesús al Padre. Las tiernas palabras del versículo 27: "No se turben sus corazones", también se pronunciaron al comienzo de este discurso. El regreso de Jesús al Padre, después de su pasión, traerá consigo una nueva relación y una nueva era: la del Espíritu Santo.

Jesús nos da tres promesas maravillosas en el Evangelio de hoy: (1) Si los discípulos (es decir, nosotros también) guardan la Palabra de Jesús, Dios morará en ellos; (2) el Espíritu Santo continuará enseñándonos; y (3) tendrán la poderosa paz de Jesús. Ni los discípulos ni nosotros estaremos solos en la tarea de guardar la Palabra de Jesús. Dios y la Iglesia están con nosotros.

STEWARDSHIP CORNER

TIME ✦ TALENT ✦ TREASURE ✦ By: Bill Vigil

In today's Gospel we witness the last evening Jesus spends with his disciples before his death. He has already made it clear that his followers will show their love for him by serving others. To live that kind of love, they will need the active presence of God in their midst. Jesus tells his disciples that he and his Father will come and make their home with them. He also tells them that the Holy Spirit will be among them to teach them and remind them of all that Jesus had taught. Good stewards recognize that God is in their midst and that the Holy Spirit is guiding them. How often do we acknowledge God's presence in our lives? How often do we allow the Holy Spirit to guide us?

The Scripture readings of the season are especially helpful. We hear once again the stories of the appearances of Jesus to his friends; how often they failed, initially, to recognize him in his glory. The Acts of the Apostles tell us of the struggles and the excitement of the new community of believers.

Para vivir ese amor, necesitarán la presencia activa de Dios en medio de ellos. Jesús les dice a sus discípulos que él y su Padre vendrán y morarán con ellos. También les dice que el Espíritu Santo estará entre ellos para enseñarles y recordarles todo lo que Jesús enseñó. Los buenos administradores reconocen que Dios está en medio de ellos y que el Espíritu Santo los guía. ¿Con qué frecuencia reconocemos la presencia de Dios en nuestras vidas? ¿Con qué frecuencia permitimos que el Espíritu Santo nos guíe?

Las lecturas bíblicas de este tiempo son especialmente útiles. Escuchamos una vez más los relatos de las apariciones de Jesús a sus amigos; con qué frecuencia, al principio, no lo reconocieron en su gloria. Los Hechos de los Apóstoles nos hablan de las dificultades y la emoción de la nueva comunidad de creyentes.
