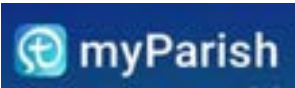

Please welcome Father Socrate Laupe, C.M. beginning August 1, 2026. Father Laupe replaces Fr. Toshio Sato, who is moving to his New Assignment. We thank Fr. Toshio for his service and pray for a smooth transition for both priests.

Fr. Socrate Laupe, C.M.

I was born in Haiti, where I was raised until adulthood. After completing my studies, I became acquainted with the Vincentian Community in Port-au-Prince and began an external experience as an aspirant. I entered the seminary in 1998 as a postulant and subsequently studied philosophy. In 2001, I was transferred to the Dominican Republic to undertake the internal seminary program (Novitiate) and subsequently study theology for four years in that country. In 2006, I received the Order of Diaconate, after which I began a two-year pastoral experience at the Parish of Santa Luisa de Marillac in Santo Domingo. My priestly ordination took place on April 5, 2008, at the Parish of La Milagrosa in Port-au-Prince, Haiti.

Pastoral Experience

From December 2006 to June 2009, I served first as a deacon and later as a parochial vicar at Santa Luisa de Marillac, in the Los Tres Brazos neighborhood of Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic. From there, I was sent to the Diocese of San Pedro de Macorís, where I served for seven months (June–December 2009) as a parochial vicar at the Parish of San Antonio de Padua, in El Puerto, San Pedro de Macorís. From January 2010 to March 2011, I served as a missionary at the Parish of San José de Los Llanos, San Pedro de Macorís. After leaving that assignment, I assisted at the Community's Major Seminary for three months. In March 2011, the Provincial Superior, Tulio Enrique Cordero, asked me to go and serve in Puerto Rico, appointing me as parochial vicar at the Parish of San Vicente de Paúl in Ponce, Puerto Rico. Two years after arriving at that parish, I was appointed Pastor of the Parish of La Milagrosa and Director of the parish school. While I was there, I served as a provincial councilor for three years (2018–2021).

At the end of 2022, I wrote to the Provincial Superior and his council, requesting a brief leave from my province to assist in one of the U.S. provinces and to learn some English. Consequently, I was welcomed by the U.S. Western Province, where I have been serving since March 2023—to the present—collaborating with the Hispanic Ministry at St. Vincent de Paul Parish in Los Angeles.

Creole, French, Spanish, and currently learning English.

P. Sócrates Laupe, C.M.

Nací en Haití, donde me crié hasta alcanzar la edad adulta. Tras completar mis estudios, entré en contacto con la Comunidad Vicentina en Puerto Príncipe y comencé una experiencia externa como aspirante. Ingresé en el seminario en 1998 como postulante y, posteriormente, estudié filosofía. En 2001, fui trasladado a la República Dominicana para realizar el programa de seminario interno (Noviciado) y, a continuación, estudiar teología durante cuatro años en ese país. En 2006, recibí el Orden del Diaconado, tras lo cual inicié una experiencia pastoral de dos años en la Parroquia de Santa Luisa de Marillac, en Santo Domingo. Mi ordenación sacerdotal tuvo lugar el 5 de abril de 2008 en la Parroquia de La Milagrosa, en Puerto Príncipe, Haití.

Experiencia pastoral

Desde diciembre de 2006 hasta junio de 2009, serví primero como diácono y, posteriormente, como vicario parroquial en Santa Luisa de Marillac, en el barrio Los Tres Brazos de Santo Domingo, República Dominicana. Desde allí, fui enviado a la Diócesis de San Pedro de Macorís, donde serví durante siete meses (junio-diciembre de 2009) como vicario parroquial en la Parroquia de San Antonio de Padua, en El Puerto, San Pedro de Macorís. De enero de 2010 a marzo de 2011, serví como misionero en la Parroquia de San José de Los Llanos, en San Pedro de Macorís. Tras concluir esa asignación, colaboré en el Seminario Mayor de la Comunidad durante tres meses. En marzo de 2011, el Superior Provincial, Tulio Enrique Cordero, me pidió ir a servir a Puerto Rico, nombrándome vicario parroquial en la Parroquia de San Vicente de Paúl, en Ponce, Puerto Rico. Dos años después de llegar a dicha parroquia, fui nombrado Párroco de la Parroquia de La Milagrosa y Director de la escuela parroquial. Durante mi estancia allí, serví como consejero provincial durante tres años (2018-2021).

A finales de 2022, escribí al Superior Provincial y a su consejo solicitando una breve licencia de mi provincia para colaborar en una de las provincias de los Estados Unidos y aprender algo de inglés. En consecuencia, fui acogido por la Provincia Occidental de los Estados Unidos, donde he estado prestando servicio desde marzo de 2023—hasta la actualidad—, colaborando con el Ministerio Hispano en la Parroquia San Vicente de Paúl, en Los Ángeles.
