GOOD STEWARDS AVOID “COMPASSION FATIGUE”

One of the spiritual maladies Christians face today is “compassion fatigue.” The media inundates us with details of disasters, natural and made, far and wide. We can’t turn on the television without being assailed by news stories of another event that cries to us for help, and our mailboxes are full of pleas from worthy charities. We try to give out of a sense of compassion, but the needs of the world overwhelm us. Generous givers become “fatigued” and grow weary. We can’t respond to all the problems and crises in the world, can we? Of course we can’t respond to the cries of a suffering world with our comparatively meager resources. If we try to respond to every crisis, to say “yes” to every loud or consistent plea for help, it is no surprise that we feel tired and discouraged. Our efforts to respond generously can become scattered and not well thought out, and sometimes our giving becomes motivated by guilt rather than compassion. Eventually, we may stop giving. Good stewards understand that, though Christ calls them to embrace a needy world with compassion, they cannot solve the world’s problems themselves and that a balance must be struck in their spiritual lives. Christian stewards prayerfully discern how they are able to respond to the needs of the world. They budget their time and resources so that their response can be generous but focused, sacrificial but not overwhelming. They begin with a prayerful commitment to their immediate family of faith. Being generous to one’s faith community can go a long way toward meeting the needs of others. Their response to the diocesan annual appeal and to special collections also makes them part of a larger faith community’s response to the poor and marginalized. For some, this focused generosity may be the extent of their ability to give financially. The decision to give is made prudentially and without guilt. For others, a well thought-out approach to supporting other charitable causes can be part of their stewardship planning as well. But for Christian stewards the giving does not stop there. Good stewards realize that the greatest gift they can give is the gift of prayer.

LOS BUENOS ADMINISTRADORES EVITAN LA «FATIGA POR COMPASIÓN».

Una de las dolencias espirituales que enfrentan los cristianos hoy en día es la “fatiga de la compasión”. Los medios de comunicación nos inundan con detalles de desastres, tanto naturales como provocados por el hombre, ocurridos en todas partes. No podemos encender el televisor sin vernos bombardeados por noticias sobre algún nuevo suceso que clama por ayuda, y nuestros buzones se llenan de peticiones de organizaciones benéficas dignas de apoyo. Intentamos dar movidos por la compasión, pero las necesidades del mundo nos abruma. Quienes dan generosamente terminan sintiéndose “fatigados” y agotados. No podemos responder a todos los problemas y crisis del mundo, ¿verdad? Por supuesto, no podemos responder a los clamores de un mundo que sufre utilizando únicamente nuestros recursos, que resultan comparativamente escasos. Si intentamos responder a cada crisis, diciendo “sí” a cada petición de ayuda insistente o apremiante, no es de extrañar que nos sintamos cansados y desanimados. Nuestros esfuerzos por responder con generosidad pueden volverse dispersos y poco meditados; a veces, nuestra contribución nace más de la culpa que de la compasión. Con el tiempo, es posible que dejemos de dar. Los buenos administradores comprenden que, aunque Cristo los llama a acoger con compasión a un mundo necesitado, no pueden resolver por sí solos los problemas mundiales y deben encontrar un equilibrio en su vida espiritual. Los administradores cristianos discernen en oración cómo pueden responder a las necesidades del mundo. Organizan su tiempo y sus recursos para que su respuesta sea generosa pero centrada, y suponga un sacrificio sin llegar a abrumarlos. Comienzan con un compromiso, asumido en oración, hacia su propia comunidad de fe. Ser generoso con la comunidad de fe contribuye enormemente a satisfacer las necesidades de los demás. Su respuesta a la campaña anual de la diócesis y a las colectas especiales los hace partícipes, además, de la respuesta de una comunidad de fe más amplia ante los pobres y marginados. Para algunos, esta generosidad centrada puede representar el límite de su capacidad para contribuir económicamente. La decisión de dar se toma con prudencia y sin sentimientos de culpa. Para otros, un enfoque bien planificado para apoyar otras causas benéficas también puede formar parte de su gestión de la corresponsabilidad. Pero, para los administradores cristianos, la generosidad no termina ahí. Los buenos administradores reconocen que el mayor regalo que pueden ofrecer es la oración.

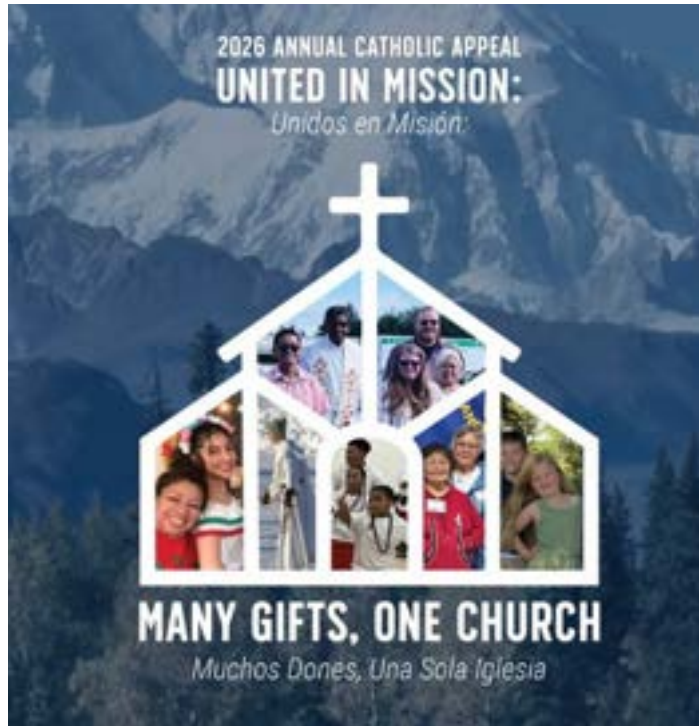

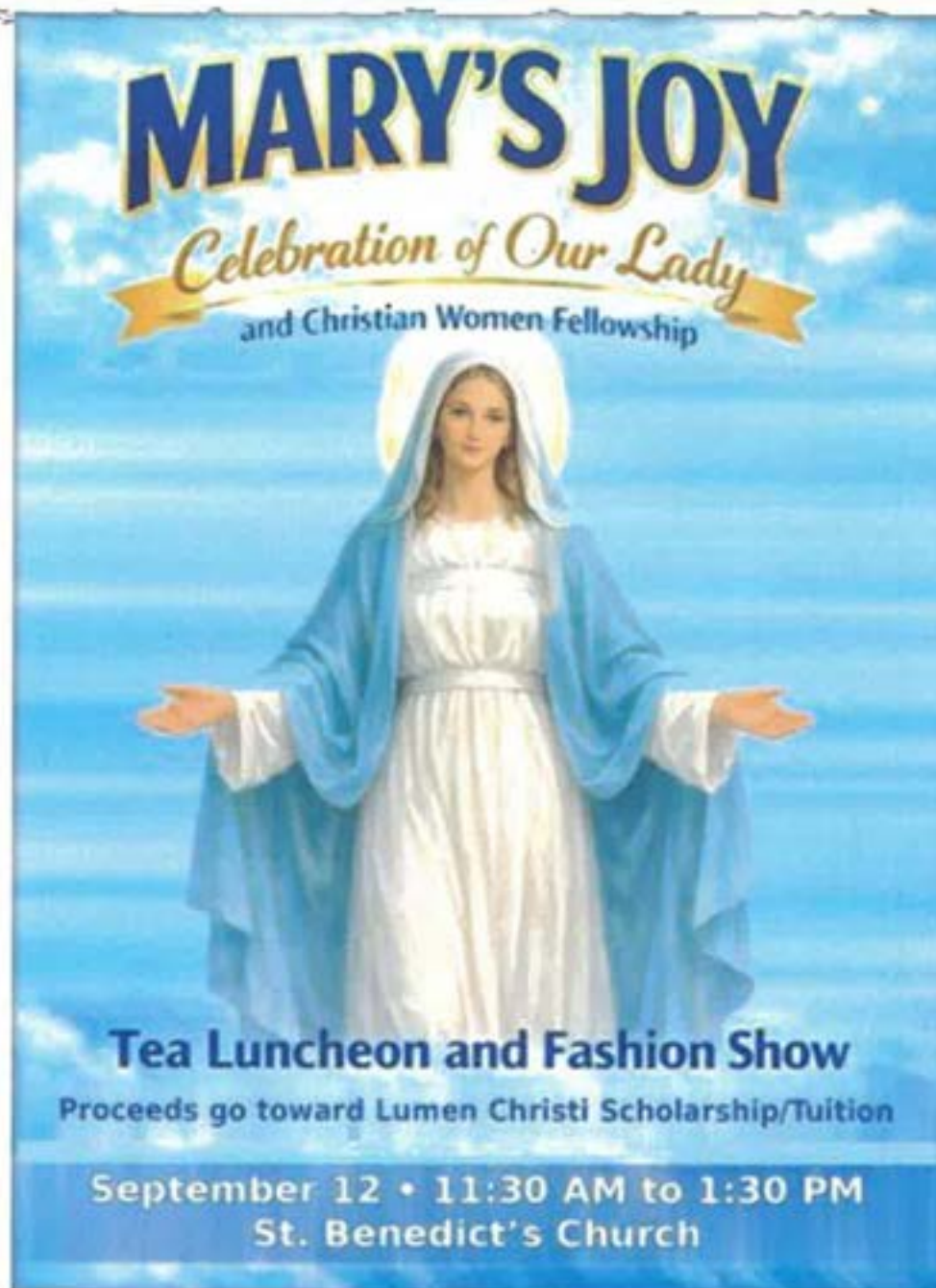
