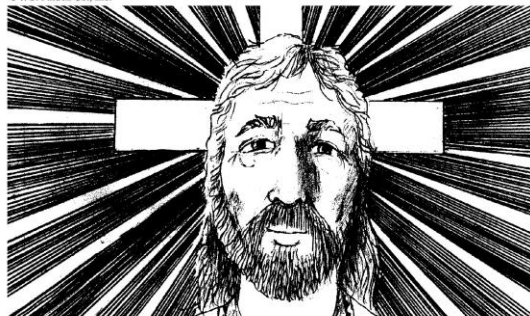

My dear sisters and brothers,

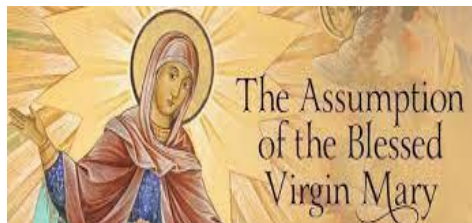

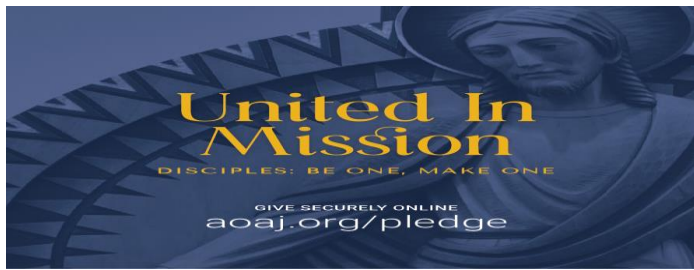

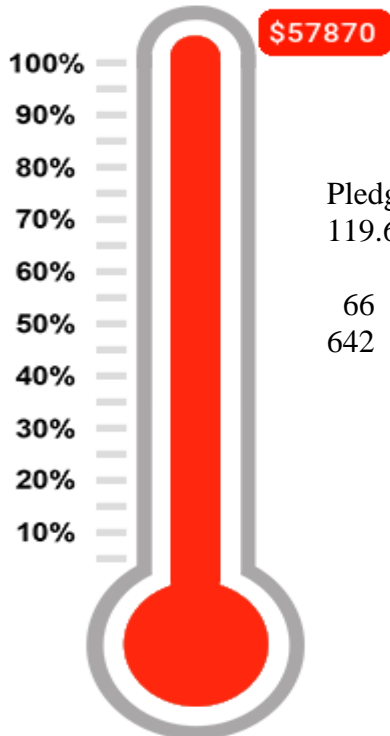

In today's second reading, we hear the author of the letter to the Hebrews liken the daily life of the Christian steward to a race, a long-distance race perhaps, certainly not a sprint; requiring endurance and a single-minded focus on Jesus at the finish line. Good stewards are firmly committed to running the race, to live the Christian life to the fullest, to keep their eyes focused on Jesus. They don't grow weary. They don't lose heart. They know there is immense joy waiting for them at the finish line. Are you fully committed to living each day for Christ? Are you running the race, or are you simply jogging? Just walking? Sitting? Going backwards? Going nowhere? Some of us may want to reflect on what we can do to run the race with even more conviction. Others may want to reflect on how to simply enter the race and start running

The parish is where the Church lives, and stewards are the lifeblood of a successful parish. In the parish, we find community and support, liturgy and ritual, sacrament and healing. In the parish, we find a way to give and a way to receive. On a practical level, fall is the time when parish planning gears up for the seasons ahead. Now, for a Christian steward, is the time to prayerfully consider your own involvement in the life of the parish in the coming year. How might we serve – and be served? The Christian steward knows participation in the parish is a win-win situation, feeding us as we feed others.

En la segunda lectura de hoy, en la carta a los Hebreos, el autor compara la vida cotidiana del fiel cristiano con una carrera; quizás una carrera de fondo, ciertamente no una carrera de velocidad; ésta requiere resistencia y enfoque en Jesús, en la línea de meta. Los fieles fervorosos están firmemente comprometidos en correr la carrera, en vivir la vida cristiana al máximo, manteniendo sus ojos fijos en Jesús. No se cansan. No se desaniman. Saben que les espera una alegría inmensa en la línea de meta. ¿Estás completamente comprometido a vivir cada día para Cristo? ¿Estás corriendo la carrera o simplemente estás trotando? ¿Sólo caminando? ¿Deteniéndote? ¿Devolviéndote? ¿Yendo hacia ninguna parte? Algunos de nosotros quisiéramos reflexionar sobre lo que podemos hacer para correr la carrera más decididamente. Otros podrían reflexionar sobre cómo simplemente ingresar a la carrera y comenzar a correr.

La parroquia es donde vive la Iglesia, y los delegados son el alma de una parroquia exitosa. En la parroquia encontramos comunidad y apoyo, liturgia y ritual, sacramento y sanación. En la parroquia encontramos una manera de dar y una manera de recibir. En la práctica, el otoño es el momento en que se diseña la planificación parroquial para las próximas estaciones. Ahora es el momento, para todo fiel cristiano, de considerar en oración cuál será su participación en la vida parroquial en este año. ¿Cómo podemos servir y ser servidos? El fiel cristiano sabe que la participación en la parroquia es una realidad en la que todos ganamos, alimentándonos mutuamente.
