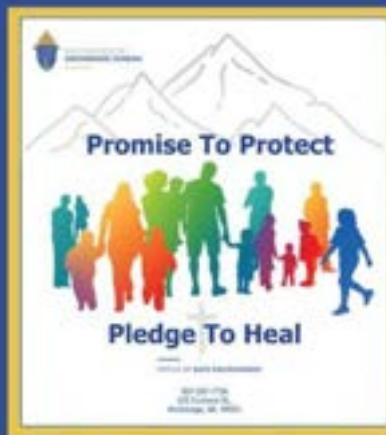

SIXTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

In today's second reading, Saint Paul bids us to take comfort in knowing that when God invites us to pray to him, he knows our true needs, even if we do not. The Holy Spirit intercedes and prays for us even if we can't come up with appropriate words; even when we don't have a clue what to ask for. We are not left alone. Good stewards know that prayer is an important part of living a life in Christ. The important thing is to make space for God. Do we let God into our hearts? Do we make room for the Holy Spirit to pray within us?

LEADING OTHERS TO CHRIST WITH OUR STEWARD'S RESPONSE BY LEISA ANSLINGER

In what ways does Christ's love touch others through your life of stewardship? How do you lead people in your community to discern how each is called to minister and serve? Do people in your community recognize that stewardship is about more than giving money to the parish or diocese? Our responses to questions such as these are at the heart of the way we approach stewardship leadership. We may say "stewardship is a way of life," yet the message we share with people in our community may sound more like, "stewardship is about giving money to the Church." The reality is, the path of discipleship, lived through stewardship, leads each of us to grow in holiness. We may struggle to put this call into words, yet we know that living and growing as good stewards is a meaningful way to connect faith with daily life. This is a gift we must give one another. It is gift that is sure to have lasting impact in the lives of individuals and the life of the faith community.

DECIMOSEXTO DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO

En la segunda lectura de hoy, san Pablo nos invita a encontrar consuelo al saber que, cuando Dios nos llama a orar, Él conoce nuestras verdaderas necesidades, aun cuando nosotros no las conozcamos. El Espíritu Santo intercede y ora por nosotros incluso cuando no encontramos las palabras adecuadas, o cuando ni siquiera sabemos qué pedir. No estamos solos. Los buenos administradores saben que la oración es una parte fundamental de una vida en Cristo. Lo importante es hacer espacio para Dios. ¿Dejamos que Dios entre en nuestros corazones? ¿Hacemos sitio para que el Espíritu Santo ore en nuestro interior?

LLEVANDO A OTROS A CRISTO CON LA RESPUESTA DE NUESTRO MAYORDOMO POR LEISA ANSLINGER

¿De qué manera el amor de Cristo llega a los demás a través de su vida de corresponsabilidad? ¿Cómo guía a las personas de su comunidad para que discernan el llamado particular que cada una tiene a ejercer un ministerio y a servir? ¿Reconocen los miembros de su comunidad que la corresponsabilidad implica mucho más que simplemente aportar dinero a la parroquia o a la diócesis? La respuesta que damos a estas preguntas es fundamental para el modo en que abordamos el liderazgo en la corresponsabilidad. Aunque digamos que «la corresponsabilidad es un estilo de vida», el mensaje que transmitimos a nuestra comunidad puede sonar más bien a que «la corresponsabilidad consiste en dar dinero a la Iglesia». En realidad, el camino del discipulado, vivido a través de la corresponsabilidad, nos conduce a cada uno de nosotros a crecer en santidad. Quizás nos cueste expresar este llamado con palabras, pero sabemos que vivir y crecer como buenos corresponsables es una forma significativa de vincular la fe con la vida cotidiana. Este es un regalo que debemos ofrecernos mutuamente; un regalo que, sin duda, dejará una huella duradera tanto en la vida de las personas como en la de la comunidad de fe.

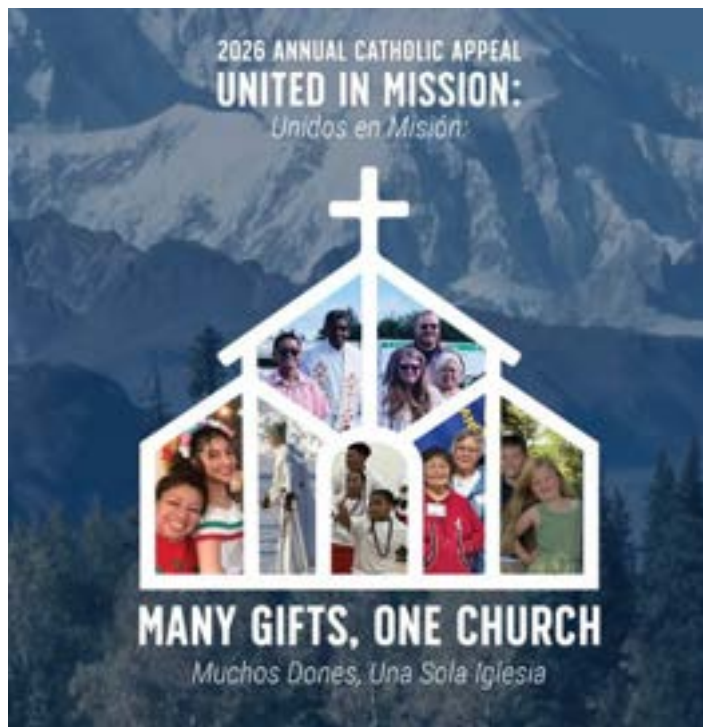
