My dear sisters and brothers,

In our passage from Mark this Sunday, we hear that a leper approached Jesus and said: “If you wish, you can make me clean.” Jesus wasted no time in responding. He touched the man! This was unheard of! He touched a leper! Jesus then said to the leper, “I do will it. Be made clean.” And immediately the leprosy left the man. Jesus then instructs the man to follow the prescriptions of the Law. Interestingly, within the next thirty-four verses of Mark, in five episodes, some consider Jesus as one who does not uphold the Law. But violates it.

Being an imitator of Christ means reaching out to the peripheries. This can be uncomfortable and inconvenient, but there is no way around the reality that our baptismal call insists that we claim this as our mission. Who is on the margins around us? Who is not yet at the table? Who is sitting right in front of us, begging to be seen? Seeing these least among us and journeying alongside them is what gives the greatest glory to God. Something to think about as we begin Lent this week.

Mis queridos hermanos y hermanas,

En nuestro pasaje de Marcos de este domingo, escuchamos que un leproso se acercó a Jesús y le dijo: “Si quieres, puedes limpiarme”. Jesús no perdió tiempo en responder. ¡Tocó al hombre! ¡Esto era inaudito! ¡Tocó a un leproso! Entonces Jesús dijo al leproso: “Yo lo quiero. Quedad limpios”. Y al momento la lepra desapareció del hombre. Luego Jesús instruye al hombre a seguir las prescripciones de la Ley. Curiosamente, en los siguientes treinta y cuatro versículos de Marcos, en cinco episodios, algunos consideran a Jesús como alguien que no cumple la Ley. Pero lo viola.

Ser imitador de Cristo significa llegar a las periferias. Esto puede ser incómodo e inconveniente, pero no hay forma de evitar la realidad de que nuestro llamado bautismal insiste en que reclamemos esto como nuestra misión. ¿Quiénes están en los márgenes que nos rodean? ¿Quién no está todavía en a mesa? ¿Quién está sentado frente a nosotros, rogando ser visto? Ver a los más pequeños entre nosotros y caminar junto a ellos es lo que da la mayor gloria a Dios. Algo en lo que pensar al comenzar la Cuaresma esta semana.

A STEWARDSHIP PRAYER for February

But our journey is with your son, Jesus, who bore his cross and suffered in ways we cannot imagine. We journey with Jesus toward the great paschal feast of Easter, where we have the grace to experience the true joy of Resurrection. Teach us to be good stewards of your mercy and forgiveness, so that we may extend these gifts to others. Give us the strength to bear witness to your son at all times, even during these times of stress and adversity. And fill our hearts with love that we may be faithful to the Gospel Jesus proclaimed and ready to celebrate our unity with him and each other. Grant this through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever.

The fate of a leper is a great tragedy at any time and place. In Jesus' time, lepers were considered condemned, part of the plagues God sent as punishment. They were cast out of society and abandoned. Saint Mark's Gospel reveals the unthinkable. Jesus reaches out and touches a leper. He risks catching the contagious disease and heals the man. As the Gospel story teaches, no one is abandoned by Christ. Are there those in our society or in our personal lives for whom we ascribe no hope, who we have abandoned, treated like lepers? Or as Christ's stewards of our sisters and brothers, do we risk reaching out and touching those who may seem to us to be "unclean" or not worthy of our time or attention?
