Understanding Stewardship in a Complex World

We know that our Catholic faith is a communal faith, not meant to be lived in isolation. Our prayer and spirituality serve as a springboard to a life of Christian charity and service to others in some form or fashion. Jesus alludes to the lives of action his disciples will lead. He speaks to God about his followers: “I do not ask that you take them out of the world, but that you keep them from the evil one” (John 17:15). As a communion of Christian stewards, we live our Catholic faith in a challenging world. We see overwhelming problems and social ills, and we’re bombarded from so many sides to take action. We are sometimes hit by “compassion fatigue,” and often the issues are complex and our response unsure. There are a host of Catholic agencies that can help us better understand Catholic social teaching and how we apply that teaching to the complexity of world issues that surround us. Catholic Relief Services and Jesuit Refugee Services, to name just two, deal with international issues with a focus on faith, and Catholic Charities USA focuses on domestic issues. But are you aware that our United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) addresses many issues on the domestic and international front, through its educational resources as well as its activities? Many times, news reports focus on the Church’s position on one or two issues. But in reality, the bishops are very active and outspoken on a wide range of social concerns, and by joining with them as people of faith we can create a united front that promotes positive change and enhances the common good. Through its teachings and programs, the USCCB addresses issues such as human trafficking, hunger among our nation’s poor, the human suffering brought on by Syria’s civil war, employment, health care, the environment, education and capital punishment. Visiting www.usccb.org can bring you up to date on a wide range of issues and show you how you can help address them by applying the teachings of our Catholic faith. Together as a communion of faith we can make a difference as we live in this world as Christ directed even in these disquieting times.

Entendiendo la mayordomía en un mundo complejo

Sabemos que nuestra fe católica es una fe comunitaria, no destinada a ser vivida en aislamiento. Nuestra oración y espiritualidad sirven como trampolín para una vida de caridad cristiana y servicio a los demás de alguna forma o manera. Jesús alude a la vida de acción que llevarán sus discípulos. Le habla a Dios de sus seguidores: “No te pido que los quites del mundo, sino que los guardes del mal” (Juan 17:15). Como comunión de administradores cristianos, vivimos nuestra fe católica en un mundo desafiante. Vemos problemas abrumadores y males sociales, y somos bombardeados desde muchos lados para que tomemos medidas. A veces nos golpea la "fatiga de la compasión" y, a menudo, los problemas son complejos y nuestra respuesta es incierta. Hay una gran cantidad de agencias católicas que pueden ayudarnos a comprender mejor la enseñanza social católica y cómo aplicamos esa enseñanza a la complejidad de los problemas mundiales que nos rodean. Los Servicios Católicos de Ayuda y los Servicios Jesuitas a Refugiados, por nombrar solo dos, se ocupan de asuntos internacionales con un enfoque en la fe, y Caridades Católicas de EE. UU. se enfoca en asuntos nacionales. Pero, ¿sabe usted que nuestra Conferencia de Obispos Católicos de los Estados Unidos (USCCB, por sus siglas en inglés) aborda muchos temas en el frente nacional e internacional, a través de sus recursos educativos y sus actividades? Muchas veces, los informes noticiosos se enfocan en la posición de la Iglesia en uno o dos temas. Pero en realidad, los obispos son muy activos y abiertos en una amplia gama de preocupaciones sociales, y uniéndonos a ellos como personas de fe podemos crear un frente unido que promueva un cambio positivo y mejore el bien común. A través de sus enseñanzas y programas, la USCCB aborda temas como la trata de personas, el hambre entre los pobres de nuestra nación, el sufrimiento humano provocado por la guerra civil de Siria, el empleo, la atención médica, el medio ambiente, la educación y la pena capital. Visitar www.usccb.org puede ponerlo al día sobre una amplia gama de temas y mostrarle cómo puede ayudar a abordarlos aplicando las enseñanzas de nuestra fe católica. Juntos como comunión de fe podemos marcar la diferencia mientras vivimos en este mundo como Cristo lo dirigió, incluso en estos tiempos inquietantes.
