Dear Church,

“Christ is risen!” “He is truly risen!”—this is the greeting and response of many Eastern Rite Christians on Easter. There is a certain simplicity and exuberance to these words. For us Christians, this feast is not primarily about chocolate rabbits and colored hard-boiled eggs (although they’re a nice extra), but about a God who loved us so much that he sent his only-begotten Son whom he raised to life after an ignominious death. Jesus Christ is the first-born of the dead. We have been baptized into his very death and resurrection. We will also rise one day.

Through this season we will be reminded by the scriptures in various ways that we are to live as heirs of eternal life right now. Peter and Paul will remind us through their letters. Luke will mind us as he describes for us the life of that early community of the Risen Christ. For now, let us celebrate. The church celebrates the “day” of Easter for eight days; the Easter Season continues until Pentecost—a full 50 days. Let us bask in the light of the Paschal Candle as we celebrate and ponder the new life promised us by our Risen Lord. Christ is risen! He is truly risen!

Pedro y Pablo nos lo recuerdan a través de sus cartas. Lucas nos tiene en cuenta mientras nos describe la vida de la comunidad primitiva del Cristo Resucitado. Por ahora, celebremos. La iglesia celebra el “día” de Pascua por ocho días; el Tiempo de Pascua continua hasta Pentecostés – un total de 50 días. Disfrutemos de la luz del Cirio Pascual mientras celebramos y reflexionamos la vida nueva que se nos prometió a través del Señor Resucitado. ¡Cristo ha resucitado! ¡Él verdaderamente ha resucitado!






STEWARDSHIP

Managing God's Gifts To Us

"A Stewardship Moment: Jesus Christ has risen today! For those good stewards of their faith who die with Jesus, they rise with Christ their savior every day. They are an Easter people. Our Savior is active, alive, and transforming us and our communities of faith, even the world, at this very moment. Easter is a time of joy, a time of celebration. To have faith in the risen Lord is also to believe that we are disciples who bear witness to Christ in a broken and troubled world. To be good stewards of this faith obliges us to be living witnesses to Christ's peace at home and in public. Jesus cannot be found buried in some long forgotten time, in some far away land. He is risen. He lives within each one of us. Alleluia!"

Why Do We Celebrate Easter Sunday?

Easter Sunday brought us new life in several ways. Jesus brought new life to us (via salvation), he brought new life to the world (by advancing the kingdom of God), and he brought new life to our understanding of the world (by having his physical body resurrected, showing that God cares about the physical). Think about these quotes as you consider what new life Jesus has brought for you:

“The message of the resurrection is that this world matters! That the injustices and pains of this present world must now be addressed with the news that healing, justice, and love have won.”

¿Por qué celebramos el Domingo de Pascua?
