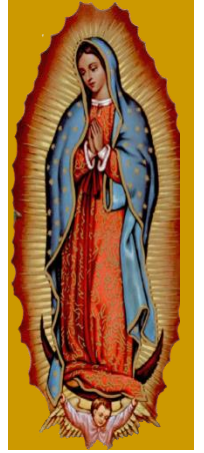

Dear Church,

In the first reading we have Isaiah giving us the vision that Jesus is fulfilling in the gospel. When the gospel's deaf man encounters Christ, he becomes a fulfillment of this prophecy. The pairing of these readings reminds us that Each of Jesus' miracles is part of a bigger project, the project of restoring creation to the wholeness God intended for it. But this big sweeping project, a work still in progress, is also made up of individuals like the deaf man—people whose stories and lives are changed by their encounter with Christ.

In today's gospel, the crowds bring to Jesus a man who is deaf and has a speech impediment. Let us consider for a moment this man's predicament. Being unable to hear or speak properly put this man at an extreme disadvantage in first century society where people primarily communicated through spoken word. Some in the crowd brought this man to Jesus and begged him for a cure. Jesus heals the man in an unusual way—by touching his tongue, sticking his finger in the man's ear, and crying out "Ephphatha! . . . Be opened!" This message is meant for the deaf man and for all of us. Jesus tells us to be open to God's calling, to the work of healing, to caring for our neighbors in need.

Querida Iglesia,

En la primera lectura tenemos a Isaías dándonos la visión que Jesús está cumpliendo en el evangelio. Cuando el sordo del evangelio se encuentra con Cristo, se convierte en el cumplimiento de esta profecía. La combinación de estas lecturas nos recuerda que cada uno de los milagros de Jesús es parte de un proyecto más grande, el proyecto de restaurar la creación a la totalidad que Dios planeó para ella. Pero este gran proyecto radical, un trabajo aún en progreso, también está formado por personas como el hombre sordo, personas cuyas historias y vidas cambian por su encuentro con Cristo.

En el evangelio de hoy, la multitud trae a Jesús a un hombre sordo y con impedimento del habla. Consideremos por un momento la situación de este hombre. Ser incapaz de oír o hablar correctamente puso a este hombre en extrema desventaja en la sociedad del primer siglo, donde la gente se comunicaba principalmente a través de la palabra hablada. Algunos entre la multitud llevaron a este hombre a Jesús y le rogaron que los curara. Jesús sana al hombre de una manera inusual: tocándole la lengua, metiendo el dedo en el oído del hombre y gritando "¡Effeta! . . . ¡Ábrete! Este mensaje está destinado al sordo y a todos nosotros. Jesús nos dice que estemos abiertos al llamado de Dios, a la obra de curación, a cuidar de nuestro prójimo necesitado..

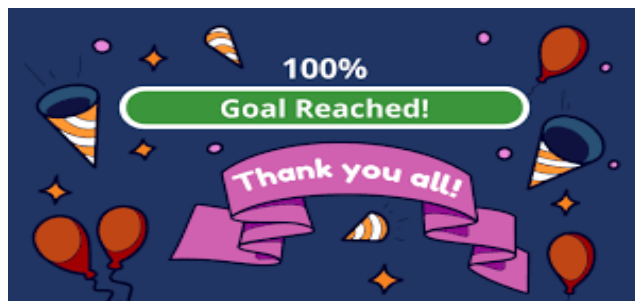
ORACIÓN DE CORRESPONSABILIDAD para septiembre
