Dear Church,

Today's gospel highlights the importance of Sabbath practice. Jesus tells the apostles: "Come away by yourselves to a deserted place and rest a while." The Son of God recognizes that daily life demands a lot from disciples then and now. To-do lists never stop growing. Our callings may pull us in many directions—a reality that makes the practice of Sabbath even more necessary. To pause from work and worry, if even for an afternoon, can renew energy for the day-to-day grind. To worship, withdraw, wonder, walk, and welcome others draws us closer to God.

Rabbi Abraham Joshua Heschel argued that the practice of Sabbath is not just a nice idea. It is a necessity, a command from God. Heschel wrote, "Unless one learns how to relish the taste of Sabbath...one will be unable to enjoy the taste of eternity in the world to come." Practicing Sabbath enables us to live into the fullness of our callings by restoring our bodies and minds. Whether practiced for a day or for an hour, Sabbath invites us to listen to the song of God's Spirit. We might ask ourselves how we might answer Jesus' invitation to rest a while this week.

El evangelio de hoy resalta la importancia de la práctica del sábado. Jesús dice a los apóstoles: "Vengan ustedes solos a un lugar desierto y descansen un poco". El Hijo de Dios reconoce que la vida diaria exige mucho de los discípulos entonces y ahora. Las listas de tareas pendientes nunca dejan de crecer. Nuestros llamados pueden llevarnos en muchas direcciones, una realidad que hace que la práctica del sábado sea aún más necesaria. Hacer una pausa en el trabajo y preocuparse, aunque sea por una tarde, puede renovar la energía para la rutina diaria. Adorar, retirarnos, maravillarnos, caminar y dar la bienvenida a los demás nos acerca a Dios.

El rabino Abraham Joshua Heschel argumentó que la práctica del sábado no es sólo una buena idea. Es una necesidad, un mandato de Dios. Heschel escribió: "A menos que uno aprenda a saborear el sabor del sábado... no podrá disfrutar el sabor de la eternidad en el mundo venidero". Practicar el sábado nos permite vivir en la plenitud de nuestros llamamientos al restaurar nuestros cuerpos y mentes. Ya sea que se practique por un día o por una hora, el sábado nos invita a escuchar el cántico del Espíritu de Dios. Podríamos preguntarnos cómo podríamos responder a la invitación de Jesús de descansar un rato esta semana.



Managing God's Gifts To Us

The Letter to the Ephesians reminds us that Christ is creating a new world order: one that brings about relationships based on love, peace, reconciliation, hope and unity. As a Eucharistic community, we are stewards of Christ's new creation. How are we promoting peace and reconciliation? How are we showing love for our neighbors? What are we doing to encourage unity and understanding among those with whom we gather around the Lord's Table each week?

Everything turns a little upside down for the family in summer. Kids out of school, grandparents visiting, teens with a first job, road trips and those big family reunions: Sometimes it seems summer dashes by in a flurry of wet bathing suits and backyard barbecues. How does the Christian steward make summer a special time for "the domestic church" of family?

Relax!... No, really!... Relax! ... Slow down! The world often spins around us and we are caught up in work, social media, activity. Gift yourself and your family with time this summer. Be truly present. On one occasion, when Pope Francis addressed a homily to families, one word he used often was "simplicity."

Niños que no van a la escuela, abuelos de visita, adolescentes con su primer trabajo, viajes por carretera y esas grandes reuniones familiares: a veces parece que el verano pasa rápidamente en medio de una ráfaga de trajes de baño mojados y barbacoas en el patio trasero. ¿Cómo hace el mayordomo cristiano que el verano sea un tiempo especial para "la iglesia doméstica" de la familia?

¡Relájate!... ¡No, de verdad!... ¡Relájate! ... ¡Desacelerar! El mundo a menudo gira a nuestro alrededor y estamos atrapados en el trabajo, las redes sociales y la actividad. Regálale tiempo a ti y a tu familia este verano. Esté verdaderamente presente. En una ocasión, cuando el Papa Francisco dirigió una homilia a las familias, una palabra que utilizó con frecuencia fue "sencillez".
