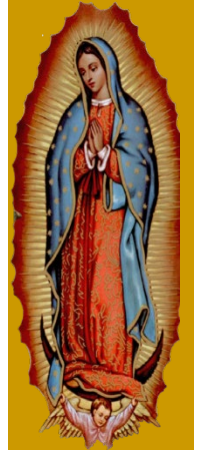

Dear Church,

We begin reading from the sixth chapter of the Gospel of John for the next few weeks. This is a story that obviously foreshadows the Eucharist, and it is also a story about finding abundance where scarcity seems to reign. A common take on this story is that the food was there all along, but the crowd refused to share out of fear it would not be enough. Only when they saw the boy's generosity were others inspired to share what they had, too, and as loaves were passed more pockets were opened until there was more than enough. This read of the story does not mean to diminish this as a miracle but rather to point out that God often works miracles through us. Our generosity and our gifts are how God changes the world. Jesus feeds us through each other. When Jesus is present, abundance is there. When Jesus is with us, we will find we have everything we need.

The abundance God promises is not always easy to see. We are often weighed down by a lack of resources—there is never enough time or energy or money to accomplish all we feel we should. But when God is with us, we most often find we have enough. Whether that means creatively revisioning how we use existing resources or stripping away excess so that our resources are well-dedicated to our mission.

Querida Iglesia,

Comenzaremos la lectura del sexto capítulo del Evangelio de Juan durante las próximas semanas. Esta es una historia que obviamente presagia la Eucaristía, y también es una historia sobre cómo encontrar abundancia donde parece reinar la escasez. Una interpretación común de esta historia es que la comida estuvo allí todo el tiempo, pero la multitud se negó a compartirla por temor a que no fuera suficiente. Sólo cuando vieron la generosidad del niño se sintieron inspirados otros a compartir lo que ellos también tenían, y a medida que se pasaban los panes se abrían más bolsillos hasta que hubo más que suficiente. Esta lectura de la historia no pretende restar importancia a esto como un milagro, sino más bien señalar que Dios a menudo obra milagros a través de nosotros. Nuestra generosidad y nuestros regalos son cómo Dios cambia el mundo. Jesús nos alimenta unos a través de otros. Cuando Jesús está presente, la abundancia está ahí. Cuando Jesús esté con nosotros, descubriremos que tenemos todo lo que necesitamos.

La abundancia que Dios promete no siempre es fácil de ver. A menudo nos sentimos agobiados por la falta de recursos: nunca hay suficiente tiempo, energía o dinero para lograr todo lo que creemos que deberíamos. Pero cuando Dios está con nosotros, la mayoría de las veces descubrimos que tenemos suficiente. Ya sea que eso signifique revisar creativamente cómo utilizamos los recursos existentes o eliminar el exceso para que nuestros recursos estén bien dedicados a nuestra misión.

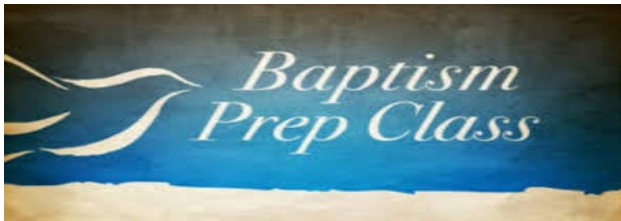
